

COUNTY OF AVONROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 23PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of Avon in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and after consultation with the chief officer of police, intends to vary the "Scheme for the Establishment of Crossings for Foot Passengers in the County of Avon" by the addition thereto, of the following push button controlled (pelican) crossings in the District of Wansdyke:-

Across A4 Bath Road, west of the roundabout at its junction with the A4175, Hicks Gate	2 (Pelicans)

A copy of the map together with a statement of reasons may be inspected at the undermentioned offices (callers should report to reception and ask for the Statutory Orders Section), during normal office hours, and at Keynsham Public Library, The Centre, Keynsham, during normal opening hours.

Objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to the County Solicitor and Clerk at the undermentioned address quoting reference NT-P-5-022 by 22nd March 1995. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the County Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.
