

COUNTY COUNCIL OF AVON(CITY OF BATH)(DOCTORS' STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 1976

The County Council of Avon in exercise of their powers under sections 35, 36, 37 and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of October 1976 and may be cited as the 'County Council of Avon (City of Bath) (Doctors' Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1976.'
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of section 38 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the parts of the Order revoked by Article 3 of this Order were parts of an Act of Parliament thereby repealed.
3. The City of Bath (Doctors Street Parking Places) Order 1972 shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) in Article 2(1) thereof there were substituted for the definition of the expression "Council" the following definition:-
"Council" means the 'County Council of Avon.'
 - (b) in the Schedule thereto there were deleted the entries numbered D1 and D2 and inserted the entries so numbered set out in the Schedule to this Order.
