

COUNTY COUNCIL OF AVON
(BUS STOPS, BATH)
(RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1979

The County Council of Avon (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2), (3) and (3B) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order :-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 7th. May 1979 and may be cited as the County Council of Avon (Bus Stops, Bath) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979.

2. (1) In this Order -

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975;

"express carriage" means an express carriage as defined in section 117 of the Road Traffic Act 1960 and the Public Service Vehicles (Definition of Express Carriage) Regulations 1971;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631: 1970), but coloured orange and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

"relevant position" means -

- (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the disabled person's badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and
- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the disabled person's badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.

"restricted area" means any area of carriageway of a specified road which, for the time being, is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with either diagram 1025 or 1025.2 in Schedule 2 to The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1975.

"specified road" means any road specified in the Schedule to this Order;

"stage carriage" has the same meaning as in section 117 of the Road Traffic Act 1960

(2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Save as provided in Article 4 and Article 5 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle, other than an express carriage or a stage carriage, to wait at any time in a restricted area of a specified road.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in a restricted area of a specified road for so long as may be necessary to enable :-

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a restricted area; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to a restricted area of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (f) the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to a restricted area; or
- (g) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

Provided that the exemptions conferred by this Article in relation to the uses mentioned in paragraph (b) shall not have effect in any restricted area of a specified road between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. or between the hours of 4.15 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a bank holiday where markings on the road complying with diagram 1019 of Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs and General Directions 1975 are laid.

5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any restricted area of a specified road for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same restricted area on the same day) provided that the exemption conferred by this Article shall not have effect between the hours to which the proviso to paragraph (b) of Article 4 of this Order applies.

6. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1967 and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
