(RESERVED BUS LANE) (24 HOURS) (VARIATION NO 2) ORDER 2002**

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

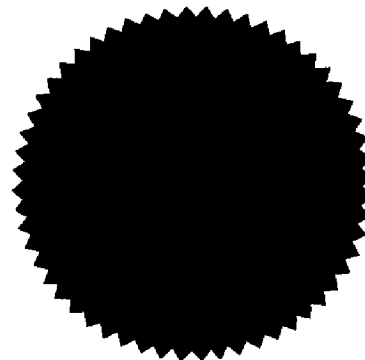
1. This Order shall come into operation on the 9th December 2002 and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (A4 London Road, Outer Area, City of Bath) (Reserved Bus Lane) (24 Hours) (Variation No 2) Order 2002.
2. The Bath and North East Somerset District Council (A4 London Road, Outer Area, City of Bath) (Reserved Bus Lane) (24 Hours) Order 2000 as varied by the Bath and North East Somerset Council (A4 London Road, Outer Area, City of Bath) (Reserved Bus Lane) (24 Hours) (Variation) (Reserved Bus Lanes) (Peak Hours) (Variation) Order 2002 is hereby varied further and shall have effect as though in Article 2(1) the "bus lane" shall be extended from a point 16 metres south west of the projected south-western kerbline of Beaufort Place north-eastwards for 162 metres.
