- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd April 2007 and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Various Roads, Bath) (Bus Lanes) (Variation) Experimental Order 2007.
- 2. The Bath and North East Somerset Council (Various Roads, Bath) (Bus Lanes) Order 2006 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though Article 7 which relates to Argyle Street and Pulteney Bridge, Bath, is deleted:
 - 7. Save as provided in Article 8, Article 9, Article 10, Article 12 or Article 13 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle other than a pedal cycle or public service vehicle in operation as a local service to be in any bus lane as specified in Schedule 5 to this Order during the operative times.

7. Save as provided in Article 8, Article 9, Article 10, Article 12 or Article 13 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle other than a pedal cycle or public service vehicle in operation as a local service or taxi to be in any bus lane as specified in Schedule 5 to this Order during the operative times.
