### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

### (VARIOUS ROADS, OUTER AREA, BATH) (RESIDENTS' PARKING) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (VARIATION) ORDER 2007

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) to (3), 45, 46, 49, 51, 53 and 63A of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (referred to as "the Act of 1984") and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (referred to as "the Act of 1991") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, makes the following Order:

- This Order shall come into operation on the 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2007 and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Various Roads, Outer Area, Bath) (Residents' Parking) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Variation) Order 2007.
- 2. The Bath and North East Somerset District Council (Various Roads, Outer Area, Bath) (Residents' Parking) (Zone A) Order 2005 as varied by the Bath and North East Somerset District Council (Outer Area, Bath) (Residents' Parking) (Zone A) (Variation No 1) Order 2005 and The Bath and North East Somerset Council (Outer Area, Bath) (Residents' and Controlled Parking) (Zone 11) Order 2007 is varied further and shall have effect as though the following items are added to Schedule 4 of the above Order:-

## <u>SCHEDULE 4</u> <u>Part 1</u> <u>Residents' Parking Places</u>

In relation to a parking place referred to in this Schedule the expression 'permitted hours' means the period between 8 am and 6 pm on Monday to Saturday (inclusive) not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a bank holiday.

	All that part of the north west side of <b>Cleveland</b> <b>Walk</b> which extends from a point 60 metres from its junction with Bathwick Hill for a distance of 140 metres in a northerly direction.		
	All that part of the south side of Sham Castle Lane which extends from a point 20 metres west of its junction with Cleveland Walk for a distance of 25 metres in a westerly direction.		
	All that part of the south side of <b>Sham Castle</b> Lane which extends from a point 130 metres west		

of its junction with St Ann's Way for a distance	
of 5 metres in a westerly direction.	

3. The Bath and North East Somerset District Council (Various Roads, Outer Area, Bath) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2005 is varied and shall have effect as though:

a) the following items are added to Schedule 1 of the above Order:-

## **SCHEDULE 1**

### No Waiting At Any Time

St Ann's Way	West side	From a point 20 metres south of its junction with Sham Castle Lane for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction.
Sham Castle Lane	South side	From a point 120 metres west of its junction with St Ann's Way for a distance of 8 metres in a westerly direction.

And

b) the following items are added to Schedule 3 of the above Order:-

### **SCHEDULE 3**

# Limited waiting not exceeding two hours between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Saturday, no return within one hour

Cleveland Walk	West side	From a point 20 metres south of its junction with Sham Castle Lane for a distance of 100 metres in a southerly direction.
Sham Castle Lane	South side	From a point 20 metres west of its junction with Cleveland Walk for a distance of 25 metres in a westerly direction.
