BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

(BATHWICK HILL, BATH) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING) (DESIGNATED PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2008

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) to 4(3), 32 and 45 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

PART I

<u>General</u>

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 31st October 2008 and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Bathwick Hill, Bath) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading) (Designated Parking Places) Order 2008.
- 2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them: -
 - "delivered" and "collected" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;
 - "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
 - "disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000;
 - "goods" means any article not easily carried by hand and includes postal packets of any description;
 - "goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description, or a trailer so adapted;
 - "relevant position" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
 - "road" means any road (whether described by a single name or by a combination of names) or any length or side of a length or end of a road.

- (2) For the purposes of this Order, a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if the badge is exhibited in the manner referred to in relation to the display of a disabled person's badge in Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- (4) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

PART II

Prohibition of Loading/Unloading/Waiting

3. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, or load or unload any vehicle in any road or length of road as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

Designation of Parking Places

- 4. (1) Each part of the carriageway of a road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order is designated as a loading bay.
 - (2) The Council shall indicate the limits of any parking place on the carriageway by appropriate carriageway markings.
- 5. (1) No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a loading bay as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order, unless the vehicle is a goods vehicle and then only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable goods to be loaded, unloaded, delivered or collected, during the permitted hours.
 - (2) The permitted hours for each loading bay as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order are from 9.00 a.m. 4.30 p.m. Monday Saturday; 6.30 p.m. 9.00 p.m. Monday Saturday and 9.00 a.m. 6.00 p.m. Sundays and Bank Holidays.


