The North Bedfordshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Bedfordshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance was Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. (i) For the purposes of this Order

"authorised cab rank" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.1 in Schedule 2 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981.

"cycle parking place" means a part of a road authorised for use by an Order made by the North Bedfordshire Borough Council as a parking place for motor cycles.

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemption for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986, as amended.

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982, as amended.

"Hackney Carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 38(1) of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971.

"motor cycle" has the same meaning as in the relevant cycle parking place order made by the North Bedfordshire Borough Council.

"parking disc" means a disc issued by a local authority coloured orange, capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, and with an overall size of 125mm square.

- (ii) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded
 as displaying -
 - (a) a disabled person's badge issued before 2nd March 1992 in the relevant position if, -
 - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward

- (iii) Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait on the side and length of road referred to in the Twenty Seventh Schedule to this Order if the person is a registered medical practitioner in general practice in Lansdowne Road or Union Street and who holds a valid permit issued by the Council which is displayed in a prominent position on that vehicle.

- 25. The North Bedfordshire Borough Council (Various Roads, Bedford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Consolidation Order 1982 as amended, is hereby revoked.
- 26. This Order shall come into operation on the 4th day of May 1992 and may be cited as "North Bedfordshire Borough Council (Various Roads, Bedford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Consolidation Order 1992.
