

THE COUNTY OF BEDFORDSHIRE (BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (TOWN CENTRE PEDESTRIANISED AREA) (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2003)
(AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2006

The Council of the County of Bedfordshire ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 2(3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, and in agreement with Bedford Borough Council, hereby makes the following Order:-

The "Bedford Borough Council (Town Centre Pedestrianised Area) (Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2003" shall have effect subject to the following amendments:-

Amend Article 6 (Restrictions within Pedestrianised Area)

To delete Article 6 and to insert new Article 6:-

6. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle (including a pedal cycle) to enter, proceed or wait along those lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this order.

Amend Article 7 (General exemption from restrictions)


To delete Article 7 and to insert new Article 7:-

7. Nothing In Article 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit a pedal cycle being pushed by hand to enter or proceed in any direction, or to wait, within the pedestrianised area.

This Amendment shall be read and construed as one with the Bedford Borough Council (Town Centre Pedestrianised Area) (Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2003 as amended.

This amendment shall come into force on the 18th day of September.2006 and may be cited as the "The County of Bedfordshire (Bedford Borough Council (Town Centre Pedestrianised Area) (Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2003) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2006"
