

# BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL) (BEDFORD CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE)) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2008 (AMENDMENT NO.18) ORDER 2013

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers under Section 1(1), 2(1), to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- This Order shall come into operation on the 12<sup>th</sup> August 2013 and may be cited as "Bedford Borough Council (Bedfordshire County Council (Bedford Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2008 (Amendment No.18) Order 2013"
- 2. As from the date upon which the Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (Bedford Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) Order 2008 as amended" shall be varied as follows:

Delete existing Article and insert the following Article in its place:-

**SECTION 6 – RESIDENTS PERMITS** 

Application for, and issue of resident permit

Article 67 (1):

With the exception of residents of new developments of flats/apartments/homes, which have been constructed/adapted after the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2008 and a property which has been modified, adapted or altered in anyway which would cause the property to be a residential dwelling whether it be a single property, several individual properties or a house of multiple occupancy after the 12<sup>th</sup> August 2013; any resident on a road listed in Schedule 2 who is the owner or a sole user of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 66 may apply to the Council or authorised agent for the issue of a resident permit in respect of that vehicle, and any such application shall be made on a form issued by and obtainable from the Council or authorised agent and shall include the particulars and information required by such form to be supplied.

- (i) The plan schedule reference "Grid Reference J27 Revision 6" shall be deleted and "Grid reference J27 Revision No 7" shall be substituted.
- (ii) The plan schedule reference "Grid Reference J28 Revision 8" shall be deleted and "Grid reference J28 Revision No 9" shall be substituted.
- (iii) The plan schedule reference "Grid Reference K27 Revision 5" shall be deleted and "Grid reference K27 Revision No 6" shall be substituted.

# **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

# **Mayes Yard**

Bedford Borough Council has been approached by Bedford Corn Exchange requesting that a loading bay be installed in Mayes Yard to the side of their building. At present, parking restrictions prohibit parking on St. Paul's Square and which restricts loading and unloading to take place to the Corn Exchange and also the nearby businesses. This has put great difficulty on these businesses receiving deliveries which need to be undertaken as near as possible to the premises. It is therefore considered appropriate to install loadings bays within Mayes Yard to allow loading to take place to the nearby businesses.

### **Maitland Street**

Recent modification to commercial/residential premises has highlighted that sections of restricted parking are no longer required and that additional parking spaces can be created to meet local demand for parking capacity. Additional pay and display bays will be created and will operate in the same manner as existing bays within this road.

# **Greyfriars Bus Station Forecourt**

Following recent changes to the bus station forecourt and its parking arrangements, it transpires that motorists are frequently parking in areas which are outside of the marked bays. This manner of parking affects the movement of buses, causes congestion in a busy environment, and frequently results in obstruction to visibility near the marked pedestrian crossings. It is considered appropriate to prohibit waiting and loading on all sections of road outside of permitted parking bays.

### **Gadsby Street**

Following the opening of a new independent learning centre for people with disabilities and to aid the business and its users with parking spaces, Bedford Borough installed a bus bay to allow the bus to pull up close and alight passengers safely in front of the premises. We also installed a disabled bay for short stay users and visitors. These restrictions were in force at 'all times'. However, we have identified that there is no need for these facilities during night hours and therefore intend to reduce the operational hours of these dedicated bays. The bays will be unrestricted between the hours of 6pm and 8am and available to use by any motorist.

### **Howard Street**

It has been observed that the disabled bays are under utilised during evening/night hours. Therefore we intend to restrict these bays during day hours only and un-restrict parking in the evening. This is to allow additional on-street parking to meet the demands of the night time economy.

# **Commercial Road (west of Prebend Street)**


There is a need for additional parking spaces for residents in this built up area. There are currently pay-and-display parking bays in this road. It is considered appropriate to offer these bays to permit holders only. Alternate pay-and-display bays can be found within the vicinity.

### **Castle Lane**

There are currently parking bays made available for the sole use of buses only. It has transpired that these bays are only required by buses predominantly during day time hours. Therefore, to assist local demand for additional parking spaces, we will be restricting these bays to buses only during the day and un-restrict these bays during the evening/night for all to use.




