(PARKING PLACES AND CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE)(BIRMINGHAM)

(CONSOLIDATION)(VARIATION) (NO2) ORDER 1996

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd day of March One thousand nine hundred and ninety six and may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone)(Birmingham)(Consolidation)(Variation) (No. 2) Order 1996".
2. In this Order:
 - (1) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order.
 - (2) The Interpretation act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone)(Birmingham)(Consolidation) Order 1995 shall continue in full force and effect subject to the variations described in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE (ARTICLE 3)

Variations to the Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone)(Birmingham)(Consolidation) Order 1995(as amended)

SCHEDULE 1 PART I

In Parking Place No. 88 the figures "13.9" and "69" in the second column and "68" in the third column shall be deleted and the figures "34.5" "48" and "47" respectively substituted therefor.

SCHEDULE 1 PART II

In Parking Place No. 194 the figures "57" in the second column and "56" in the third column shall be deleted and the figures "37" and "36" respectively substituted therefor.

SCHEDULE 2 PART II

The sixth reference to PARK STREET shall be deleted from the Schedule and the following reference substituted therefor. ✓

PARK STREET

Both sides, from the line of the kerb on the north side of Fazeley Street at its junction with Masshouse Lane. ✓

In the references to PARK STREET the following references shall be added to the Schedule.

West side, from the line of the kerb on the south side of Fazeley Street for a distance of 13.9 metres in a southerly direction.

East side, from the line of the kerb on the south side of Fazeley Street for a distance of 34.5 metres in a southerly direction.

FAZELEY STREET

In the third reference the figure "19.1" shall be deleted and the figure "39" substituted therefor. ✓
