(BIRMINGHAM) (CONSOLIDATION) VARIATION) (NO. 17) ORDER 2000

Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of April Two thousand, and may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Birmingham) (Consolidation) (Variation) (No. 17) Order 2000".
- In this Order except where otherwise stated, any reference to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Birmingham) (Consolidation) Order 1995 as amended shall remain in full force and effect subject to the variations specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE (ARTICLE 3)

Variations to the Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Birmingham) (Consolidation) Order 1995 as amended.

ARTICLE 39

Immediately following reference (m) the following references shall be added:

- (n) In Pershore Street (southwesterly direction) to make a right turn into Ladywell Walk.
- (o) In Pershore Street (northwesterly direction) to make a right turn into the Markets Car Park entrance situated approximately 30 metres south of its junction with Edgbaston Street.

ARTICLE 45

Immediately following reference (g) the following reference shall be added.

(h) in a northeasterly direction in Ladywell Walk shall cause that vehicle on reaching the junction of Pershore Street with Ladywell Walk to make a left turn into Pershore Street.
