Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 5th day of July Two thousand and One and may be cited as "Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Birmingham) (Consolidation) (Variation) (No.32) Order 2001".

3. The Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Birmingham) (Consolidation) Order 1995 as amended shall continue in full force and effect subject to the variations specified in the Schedule to this Order.

## SCHEDULE (ARTICLE 3)

Variations to the Birmingham City Council (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) (Birmingham) (Consolidation) Order 1995 as amended.

Article 45 (1) (a) shall be suspended.

## SCHEDULE 1 PART 1

In Parking Place No. 41 the figures "56.6" and "45.4" in the second column and "44.4" in the third column shall be suspended and the figures "60.2", "38.2" and "37.2" respectively substituted therefor.

In Parking Place No. 42 the figure "59" in the second column and "58" in the third column shall be suspended and figures "36" and "35" respectively substituted therefor.

In Parking Place No. 43 the term south-east to be deleted and substituted by "northwest" the figures "85.1" and "53" in the second column and "52" in the third column shall be suspended and the figures "88.7", 145.8" and "44.8" respectively substituted therefor. The words "60° to the kerb" shall be inserted in the fifth column.
