

THEY CITY OF BIRMINGHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT)
(NO.1) ORDER 1986 - PART III (INNER CITY)

The City of Birmingham District Council in exercise of their powers under Section 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Constable of the West Midlands in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following order.

- 1. The City of Birmingham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1986 - Part III (Inner City) shall have the effect subject to the amendments specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the City of Birmingham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment) (No.1) Order 1986 - Part III (Inner City) and shall come into operation on the 14th day of July, 1986.

SCHEDULE

- 1. In column 4 of Part 1 of the Schedule to the Order after the words "Christmas Day" there shall be inserted "but including August Bank Holiday Sunday and Monday".
- 2. This shall apply in respect of Adelaide Street, Barford Street, Blucher Street, King Edwards Road, Macdonald Street, St. Peters Place, St. Martins Place, Tennant Street, Irving Street only.
