(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT) (NO. 3) ORDER 1988
PART III (INNER CITY)

The Birmingham City Council in exercise of their powers under Section 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of the West Midlands in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following order.

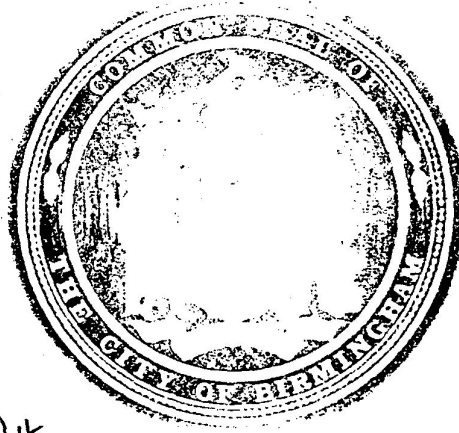
1. The City of Birmingham District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1986 - Part III (Inner City) shall have effect subject to the amendments specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as the Birmingham City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1988 - Part III (Inner City) and shall come into operation on the 19th day of December 1988.

SCHEDULE

1. Article 8(a) shall be numbered 8(a) (i).
2. Articles 8(a) (i) and 8(c) shall be amended to read an excess charge of "£20" instead of "£15".
3. The following shall be inserted as Article 8(a) (ii).

"If the driver of a vehicle to which a £20 excess charge ticket is issued makes payment within fourteen days of the issue of such ticket the amount payable shall be £15".
4. The scale of charges in Part II of the Schedule to the Order shall be amended to read "Excess Charge £20 (£15 if paid within fourteen days of issue of ticket)" instead of "Excess Charge £15".
