THE LORD MAYOR ALDERMEN AND CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM in exercise of their powers under sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 1 and sub-section (4) of Section 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order between the hours of 7.45 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6.45 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in any week.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in any week -
 - (a) for a longer period than sixty minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than sixty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order between the hours of 7.45 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. and 6.45 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in any week.
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order between the hours of 9.15 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in any week -
 - (a) for a longer period than sixty minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than sixty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.
- Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order between the hours of 7.45 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6.45 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Tednesday, Thursday and Friday in any week.

Save as provided in Article 10 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order between the hours of 7.45 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6.45 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in any week.
- 9. Nothing in Articles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the First, Second, Third and Fourth Schedules to this Order for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, provided that no vehicle shall so wait between the hours of 7.45 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6.45 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in any week.
- 10. Nothing in Articles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules to this Order, for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said lengths of road of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;
 - (c) to enable postal packets to be loaded on to or unloaded from vehicles in the service of or employed by the Postnaster General; or
 - (d) to enable a vehicle in the service of or employed by a newspaper publisher to be used in the delivery of newspapers in bulk to newsagents, provided that such vehicle shall not in any case wait for a longer period than one minute.
- 11. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, or by or under any other enactment.
- 12. The Orders specified in the Sixth Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked to the extent specified in relation thereto in column 2 of that Schedule.
