

BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL
(JEWELLERY QUARTER BIRMINGHAM)
(CONTROLLED ZONE)
(VARIATION) (NO.4) ORDER 1998

The Birmingham City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1,2,4,32,35,45,46,49, and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order.

1. The Order shall come into operation on the 11th day of May one thousand nine hundred and ninety-eight and may be cited as the Birmingham City Council (Jewellery Quarter Birmingham) (Controlled Zone) (Variation) (No.4) Order 1998.
2.
 - (i) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
 - (ii) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Birmingham City Council (Jewellery Quarter Birmingham) (Controlled Zone) Order 1992 as amended shall continue in full force and effect subject to the variations specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

Variations of The Birmingham City Council (Jewellery Quarter Birmingham)
(Controlled Zone) Order 1992

In Article 7 sub-article "(1)(b)" shall be deleted and the following sub-article shall be substituted:

- "(1) (b) seventy new pence (70p) for an initial period of not more than two hours;

In Article 12 sub-article "(1)(b)" and "(2)" shall be deleted and the following sub-articles shall be substituted:

- "(1) (b) where it is an amount of seventy new pence (70p) by the issue by the parking meter relating to the parking place in which the vehicle is left of a ticket indicating that the charge has been paid in respect of two hours and the day and time of payment of the charge, and by the display of that ticket on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of the said Article 7(3); and
- (2) The expiry of the initial period for which the initial charge has been paid shall be indicated when there is exhibited on the vehicle a ticket issued by the parking meter relating to the parking space in which the vehicle is left showing the day and time of payment of the charge and the time shown by the clock on the said parking meter is more than one hour, or, as the case may be, two hours, three hours or four hours later than the time shown on a ticket issued in respect of a payment of thirty new pence (30p) or more than two hours, or, as the case may be, three or four hours later than the time shown on a ticket issued in respect of a payment of seventy new pence (70p), or more than three hours later, or as the case may be, four hours later than the time shown on a ticket issued in respect of a payment of one pound and ten new pence (£1.10) or more than four hours later than the time shown on a ticket issued in respect of a payment of one pound fifty new pence (£1.50)."
