THE LOFD MAYOR ALDERNEN AND CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF SILVENGHAM in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with section 84C (1) of the said Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall. except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order between the hours of 7.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in any week.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order between the hours of 7.45 a.m. and 6.45 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday in any week:-
 - (a) for a longer period than sixty minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than sixty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.
- 4. Mothing in Articles 1, 2 or 3 of this Crier shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle:
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; or
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
- 5. The following vehicles left in any of the lengths of road referred to in Article 3 of this Order shall be exempt from the prohibitions therein contained:-
 - (i) an invalid carriage:
 - (ii) a vehicle issued to a disabled person by the

- 6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended as aforesaid or by or under any other enactment.
- 7. The Interpretation Act 1869 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 8. This Order shall come into operation on the Twenty-eighth day of February One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two and may be cited as "The City of Birmingham (Hockley Hill, etc.) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1972".

BARR STREET

South-west side, from the line of the kerb on the south side of New John Street West for a distance of 24 yards in a south-easterly direction.

BARR STREET

Both sides, from a point 18 yards northwest of the line of the kerb on the northwest side of Well Street to a point 16 yards south-east of the line of the kerb on the south-east side of Well Street.

BARR STREET

Both sides, from a point 15 yards northwest of the line of the kerb on the northwest side of Nockley Street to a point 19 yards south-east of the line of the kerb on the south-east side of Nockley Street.

both sides, from the line of the kerb on the north-east side of Great Hamoton Street for a distance of 14 yards in a northeasterly direction. WELL STREET Both sides, from a point 27 yards southwest of the line of the kerb on the southwest side of Barr Street to a point 25 yards north-east of the line of the kerb on the north-east side of Barr Street.
