

THE BOROUGH OF BLACKBURN (VARIOUS STREETS) (NO.9)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1987

The Council of the Borough of Blackburn (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Council of the County of Lancashire, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 1, 2, 4, and 124 of, and the Ninth Schedule to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 21st January, 1988 and may be cited as the Borough of Blackburn (Various Streets) (No.9) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1987.
2. (i) In this Order -
 - "bus stop area" means any area of carriageway in any of the lengths of road or on the side of road specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with either diagram 1025.1 or diagram 1025.3 in Schedule 2 to The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981;
 - "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;
 - "disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975;
 - "parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No 4631: 1970), but coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.
- (ii) For the purpose of Articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying -
 - (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, when -
 - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, and
 - (b) a parking disc in the relevant position, when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest to the kerb.
- (iii) For the purpose of Articles 8, 9, 10 and 11 of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position when -
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and

(b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.

(iv) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Save as provided in Articles 12(i), (ii) and (iii) and 13 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of road or in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Save as provided in Articles 12(i), (ii) and (iii) and 13 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of road or in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2.

5. Save as provided in Articles 12(i), (ii) and (iii) and 13 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the side of road or in the length of road specified in Schedule 3.

6. Save as provided in Articles 12(i), (ii) and (iii) and 13 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Saturday or a Sunday on the sides of road or in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.

7. Save as provided in Articles 12(i), (ii) and (iii) and 13 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on any Saturday from 1st September to 31st May on the sides of road or in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5.

8. Save as provided in Articles 12(i), (ii) and (iv) and 13 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of road or in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 6:-

(a) for a longer period than one half hour; or

(b) if a period of less than one half hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of road or length of road.

9. Save as provided in Articles 12(i), (ii), and (iv) and 13 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of road or in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 7:-

(a) for a longer period than half an hour; or

(b) if a period of less than half an hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of road or length of road.

10. Save as provided in Articles 12(i), (ii), and (iv) and 13 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on any day other than a Saturday or a Sunday on the side of road or in the length of road specified in Schedule 8:-

- (a) for a longer period than two hours; or
- (b) if a period of less than four hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of road or length of road.

11. Save as provided in Articles 12(i), (ii) and (iv), and 13 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 am. to 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the side of road or in the length of road specified in Schedule 9:-

- (a) for a longer period than one hour; or
- (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of road or length of road.

12. (i) Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable -

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road or side of road; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said lengths of road or side of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

(ii) Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle in the lengths of road specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9.

(iii) Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the lengths of road or on the side of road referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding two hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length or on the same side of road on the same day).

(iv) Nothing in Articles 8, 9, 10 and 11 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait on the side of road or in the length of road referred to in that Article.

13. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984, and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles other than stage carriages or express carriages in a bus stop area or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, that provision of that Order shall prevail.

14. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

15. The Orders specified in Schedule 10 are hereby revoked to the extent specified in the Second Column thereof.
