THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF BLACKBURN (CANTERBURY STREET AREA)  
(NO WAITING) ORDER 1968

The Blackburn County Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf HEREBY MAKE the following Order:

1. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 7.0 a.m. and 7.0 p.m. on any day of the week except Sunday in any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto.

2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary:

(a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; or

(b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; or

(c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, funeral, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878; or

(d) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths of road.

4. This Order shall not apply to persons suffering from any physical deformity or disability in charge of invalid carriages or vehicles specially adapted for use by disabled drivers.

5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the Road Traffic Act 1960, or by or under any other enactment.

6. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this

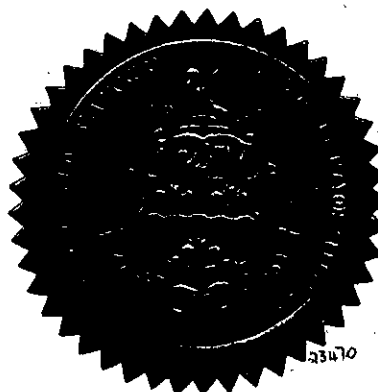

Canterbury Street	North	From the west boundary of No.4 Canterbury Street to Harrison Street
Canterbury Street	South	From Islington to Harrison Street
Harrison Street	South- West	King Street to Alice Street
Harrison Street	North- East	King Street to a point 25 yards south-east of King Street
Harrison Street	North- East	Canterbury Street to the south boundary of No.27 Harrison Street
Byrom Street	South- West	King Street to Canterbury Street
Byrom Street	West	Sumner Street to a point 10 yards south of Sumner Street
Byrom Street	West	From the entrance to the Blackburn Corporation Highways Storeyard to a point 10 yards north of this entrance
Byrom Street	East	From Pembroke Street to the north boundary of No.101 Byrom Street
Byrom Street	East	From the southern boundary of No.71 Byrom Street to the Southern boundary of No.63 Byrom Street
Byrom Street	East	From the southern boundary of No. 51 Byrom Street for a distance of 52 yards in a north-westerly direction
Byrom Street	North- East	From a point 10 yards south of St. Peter Street to the north boundary of No.35 Byrom Street
Byrom Street	North- East	From a point 10 yards south of Chapel Street to King Street
