

**THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL**  
**(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) N° 3 ORDER 2003**

---

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool in exercise of their powers under Sections 32, 33, 35, 35A, 35C, 38, 124 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (hereinafter called "the 1991 Act") and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Borough of Blackpool) Order 2003 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

**PART I**  
**GENERAL**

**1. Commencement and Citation**

This Order shall come into operation on the 10<sup>th</sup> November 2003 and may be cited as The Borough of Blackpool (Off Street Parking Places) N° 3 Order 2003.

**2. Interpretation**

**In this Order: -**

"the Council" means the Council of the Borough of Blackpool;

"authorised vehicle" means a vehicle specified in the column titled 'class of vehicles' in schedule 4 to this Order;

"class or classes of vehicle" means the class or classes of vehicle as described in Schedule 1 to this Order;

"driver" in relation to a vehicle in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle when it was left in the parking place;

"owner" has the same meaning as in the Act of 1984 and in relation to an authorised vehicle which is the subject of a hiring agreement includes the person entitled to possession of the vehicle under the agreement;

"parking place" means any area of land specified in schedule 4 to this Order being a place where vehicles of the specified classes may wait and includes all access roads and verges leading thereto and therefrom;

"parking attendant" means a parking attendant as defined in S63A of the Act of 1984 (which is inserted by S44(1) of the 1991 Act);

"parking bay" means a part of any parking place marked out for the leaving of an authorised vehicle;

"ticket machine" means any apparatus designed to issue parking tickets;

"penalty charge" and "reduced penalty charge" means a charge set by the Council under the provisions of S66 of the 1991 Act and with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport which is to be paid to the Council within 28 days beginning with the date of the notice or 14 days in the case of a reduced penalty charge following the issue of a penalty charge notice;

“penalty charge notice” means a notice issued or served by a parking attendant pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 of the 1991 Act;

“parking ticket” is a ticket purchased and issued from a ticket machine, or a parking attendant, at a parking place indicating the payment of a charge in respect of the parking place and either or both the time at which the vehicle arrived and the time at which it should leave the parking place;

“invalid carriage” means a mechanically propelled vehicle the weight of which unladen does not exceed 254 kilograms and which is specifically designed and constructed and not merely adapted for the use of a person suffering from some physical default or disability and is used solely by such a person;

“disabled persons vehicle” means a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person’s badge in accordance with the circumstances prescribed in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended;

“disabled driver” means:-

- (a) any persons driving an invalid carriage
- (b) any persons driving an authorised vehicle fitted with a badge issued in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended by the Disabled Persons 2000 (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2000 and has not ceased to be in force;

“non-motorised vehicle” means any vehicle designed or modified for use on the road which is propelled other than by a motor;

“motor car” means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being a motorcycle, goods vehicle or a coach as defined hereinafter);

“motor cycle” means a two-wheeled mechanically propelled vehicle not having a sidecar or trailer attached thereto;

“coach” means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being a goods vehicle) constructed or adapted for the carriage of more than thirteen passengers exclusive of the driver;

“commercial vehicle” means any vehicle with an unladen weight in excess of 1500kg constructed or adapted for the carriage of goods;

“parking permit” means any authorised permit purchased or issued on application to an authorised representative of the Council for the purpose of parking in a parking place, which, when displayed in the relevant position, will operate such as to satisfy the requirement to pay a charge as may be specified in this Order;

“disabled persons parking disc” means a device which:-

- (a) is 125 millimetres square and coloured blue;
- (b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid; and
- (c) is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period has begun

“relevant position” means

- (a) on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or

- (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, so that the front is clearly visible from the outside of the vehicle; or
- (c) on the windscreen so that it can be easily read from the front of the vehicle

### **3. Variation of Charges at Parking Places**

Section 35C of the Act of 1984 applies to this Order and all charges specified in this Order may be varied at any time by Notice published in accordance with the Act of 1984.

## **PART II PARKING PLACES**

### **4. Land Designated for use as parking places**

- (a) Each area of land specified in Schedule 4 to this Order may be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place for such classes of vehicle in such positions and on such days and during such hours as are specified in the said Schedule 4.
- (b) Nothing in paragraph a) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council to close all or any part of any parking place and when any parking place is so closed the Council shall display a sign or signs to this effect within the parking place and when a parking place or part thereof is so closed no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in that parking place or part thereof unless directed to do so by a person authorised by the Council to control the parking place.

### **5. Provisions as to the use of Parking Places**

- (a) Where within the parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a disabled persons vehicle the driver of a vehicle shall not cause it to wait in that parking bay unless it is a disabled persons vehicle or an invalid carriage.
- (b) Where within the parking place there is a sign indicating that a particular bay or area is reserved for a particular use the driver of a vehicle shall not cause the vehicle to wait in that parking bay or area unless it is a vehicle that is authorised by an authorised representative of the Council to so do.
- (c) Where a parking place is described in Schedule 4 to this Order as being available for vehicles of a specified class and in a specified position the driver of a vehicle shall not without the prior authority of a person authorised by the Council permit it to wait in that parking place unless it is of the class and in the position so specified.

### **6. Method of payment at parking places**

- (a) Save as is provided in paragraph (b) of this Article and Articles 12 and 13 to this Order the driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall: -
  - (i) If there is a ticket machine in any parking place, purchase from the machine a valid parking ticket OR
  - (ii) If there is a parking attendant, authorised by the council, to collect money at that parking place to pay on demand to the attendant the appropriate charge OR
  - (iii) In any other case, shall pay to the Council on demand in writing from a person authorised by the Council the appropriate charge OR

- (iv) If any other method of payment shall be authorised to pay by such methods as are authorised.
- (b) No charge shall be payable by the driver of a vehicle which is left in a parking place where the vehicle displays in the relevant position a valid Parking Permit issued in respect of the vehicle.

#### **7. Conditions of Use of Parking Tickets**

- (a) A parking ticket purchased within a parking place shall be valid only for the parking place in which it has been purchased;
- (b) A parking ticket shall be valid for the parking place in which it is purchased if and so long as the following conditions are satisfied:-
  - (i) The parking ticket is exhibited in the relevant position; and
  - (ii) The period specified on the parking ticket has not expired \_\_\_\_\_
- (c) When a parking ticket has been exhibited on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (b)(i) of this Article no person shall remove the parking ticket from the vehicle until the vehicle is removed from the parking place; and
- (d) Once a parking ticket has been used to validate a vehicle in a parking place, the transfer of the parking ticket to another vehicle is prohibited and the parking ticket shall become invalid if affixed to another vehicle.

#### **8. Liability to an amount of penalty charge at a Parking Place**

- (a) A penalty charge shall be payable by the driver of a vehicle in the circumstances described in Schedule 3 to this Order.
- (b) Where a penalty charge has been incurred a parking attendant may attach to the relevant vehicle in a conspicuous position a penalty charge notice.
- (c) A reduced penalty charge rather than a penalty charge may be payable if paid within 14 days following the issue of the penalty charge notice.

#### **9. Maximum period for which a vehicle may be left after a penalty charge has been incurred**

- (a) The period for which an authorised vehicle may be left in a parking place after the penalty charge has been incurred shall not exceed 24 hours; and
- (b) Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle notifying the driver that a penalty charge has been incurred, and that vehicle remains in the parking place for more than 24 hours a parking attendant may issue another penalty charge notice which will be additional and separate to the original penalty charge; and
- (c) Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order no person not being the driver of the said vehicle or person duly authorised by the Council shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle.

#### **10. Provisions concerning the removal of vehicles from parking places**

- (a) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in a position other than in accordance with the provisions of Article 4 of this Order a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said provisions;

- (b) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the vehicle from that parking place or arrange for such removal;
- (c) For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, or a Police Officer in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place, remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place;
- (d) Any person altering or causing to be altered the position or removal of a vehicle by virtue of and in accordance with the provisions contained in this Article may do so by towing or driving or any other means they consider are reasonably necessary to alter the position or remove the vehicle from the parking place and the Council may recover any costs so incurred from the driver of the vehicle; and
- (e) Any person removing or arranging for the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraphs (b) and (c) of this Article shall make such arrangements as they consider to be necessary for the safety of the vehicle in the place to which it is removed and the Council may recover any costs so incurred from the driver of the vehicle.

## **11. Other Provisions**

### **(a) General**

- (i) The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from the parking place;
- (ii) No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of their skills or services; and
- (iii) No person shall within a parking place, attach or cause to have attached any notice offering goods or services, except those notices that from time to time may be attached by a parking attendant authorised by the Council or such notices as may be agreed with the Police and other such authorities as being in the Public interest.

### **(b) Roadworthiness**

The driver of a vehicle shall not cause the vehicle to wait in a parking place unless the said vehicle has:-

- (i) A current road fund license or is exempt from such license; and
- (ii) The driver of the vehicle is insured to drive the said vehicle as specified in Section 143 of the Road Traffic Act 1988;
- (iii) The vehicle has a current and valid certificate of roadworthiness where such is required by law for use on the road.

### **(c) Conduct within a Parking Place**

- (i) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall not sound or permit to be sounded any horn or other similar instrument except when reasonably necessary whilst changing the position of the vehicle or to depart from the parking place;

- (ii) No person shall, in a parking place, wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance of users of the parking place or to others in the vicinity of the parking place;
  - (iii) No person shall, in a parking place, use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to cause a breach of the peace or where a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned;
  - (iv) No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle in that parking place:-
    - (1) For Sleeping or camping purposes;
    - (2) For eating or cooking purposes; and
    - (3) For the purposes of cleaning or servicing any vehicle, or part thereof, other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.
  - (v) No person shall erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council or a person duly authorised to give such consent by the Council; and
  - (vi) No person shall light or cause to be lit any fire within the parking place.
- (d) **Driving within the parking place**
- (i) No person shall, except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council, drive any vehicle in a parking place other than for the purpose of leaving it in the parking place or departing from the parking place
  - (ii) No person shall use a parking place as a means of passage from one road to another road
  - (iii) Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purposes of:
    - (1) Indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place, or
    - (2) Indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place,
 no person shall drive or cause to be driven or permit to be driven any vehicle:-
    - (1) So that it enters, or leaves, the parking place other than by the indicated routes;
    - (2) In a direction other than that specified, as the case may be unless the driver has been directed to do so by a person duly authorised by the Council to do so or a Police Officer in uniform.

## PART III

### EXEMPTIONS

#### **12. Vehicles exempt from payment of a charge at a Parking Place**

- (a) Non-motorised Vehicles - providing they are in an area within a Parking Place which is specifically designated for Non-motorised Vehicles or parked so as not to occupy a parking bay or obstruct a parking bay or an access aisle;

- (b) Motorcycles - providing they are in areas designated for Motorcycles or parked so as not to occupy a parking bay or obstruct a parking bay or an access aisle.

**13. Vehicles with partial exemption from payment**

- (a) Invalid Carriages and Disabled Person's Vehicles are exempt from payment for the period and in the Parking Places specified in Schedule 2 to this Order providing a disabled persons parking disc displaying the time of arrival is displayed so that it can be easily read through the windscreen or side window of the said vehicle after which time a valid ticket must be displayed; and
- (b) If a parking ticket is attached to such a vehicle as referred to in paragraph a) of this Article then the times shown on the ticket for the purpose of calculating the period for which the said ticket is valid shall be advanced by the period specified in Schedule 2 of this Order to allow for the period of permitted free parking.

**14. Dispensation**

Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, the Council may, at its discretion (including requiring an administration fee), issue a dispensation allowing a specific vehicle to wait in a parking place during the hours of operation of this Order without compliance with its provisions.

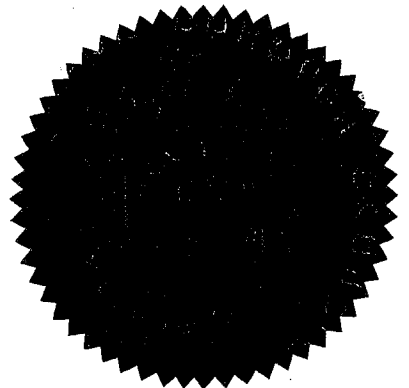
**15. Revocation**

The Borough of Blackpool (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2001, as varied by the provisions of the Borough of Blackpool (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2001 Variation N° 1 2003, the Borough of Blackpool (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2003 and the Borough of Blackpool (Off Street Parking Places) N° 2 Order 2003 are revoked hereby on commencement of this Order.
