## THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS) (VARIOUS TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2005

<u>WHEREAS</u> the Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the highway authority is satisfied that traffic should be restricted by reason that works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic Act 1991 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Borough of Blackpool) Order 2003 (Statutory Instrument No 2677) and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. NO PERSON shall cause any vehicle to proceed along Rigby Road between Tyldesley Road and the Promenade.
- 2. NO person shall cause any vehicle to wait on the north side of Princess Street for a distance of 55 metres east of its junction with Dale Street to enable the safe passage of trams on Princess Street.
- 3. NOTHING in Article 1 shall render it unlawful to cause a vehicle to proceed along the length of road referred to therein in order to gain access to the premises.
- 4. THIS Order shall come into operation on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January 2005 and continue in force until the 6<sup>th</sup> June 2005 or until the sooner completion of the works and may be cited as "The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Various Temporary Restrictions) Order 2005".
