## BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (SEASIDERS WAY & BLOOMFIELD ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2005

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1,2, 3, 4, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (which said Act is hereafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer or Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following order: -

- 1. SAVE as Provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding
- (i) South on Seasiders Way to turn right into Bloomfield Road
- (ii) North on Seasiders Way to turn left into Bloomfield Road
- (iii)West on Bloomfield Road to turn right or left into Seasiders Way
- (iv) East on Bloomfield Road to turn right or left into Seasiders Way
- 2. NOTHING in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle movement prescribed by the said Article if the vehicle is being used for emergency Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purposes.
- 3. ANY provisions contained in the said the Borough of Blackpool (various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places, One Way Traffic, Prohibition of Through Traffic, Pedestrian Areas, Weight Restrictions and Protection of Bus Stop) Order 2000 and inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby revoked.
- 4. THIS Order shall become effective from the 24<sup>th</sup> day of October 2005 and may be cited as "THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (SEASIDERS WAY & BLOOMFIELD ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2005".
