

BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL
THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (LAYTON ROAD) (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) ORDER
2005

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (which said Act is hereafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer or Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following order: -

1. IN this Order:-

"bus" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry eight or more passengers

"vehicle" shall not be taken to include non-motor vehicles

2. SAVE as Provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a bus to enter the length of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order at any time.

3. NOTHING in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the said length of road specified in the First Schedule of this Order for the purposes of any of the following:

- i) emergency police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- ii) the avoiding of an accident,
- iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any part of the said length of road;
- iv) the service of any local authority or statutory undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- v) the removal of an obstruction to traffic
- vi) gaining access to or from off-street parking, garaging, or loading premises adjacent to the said length of road

4. THE Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Consolidation of One Way Traffic, Prohibition of Through Traffic, Pedestrian Areas, Weight Restrictions and Width Restrictions) Order 2000 shall have effect as though the provisions contained in the Second Schedule to this Order were contained in and formed part of the Third Schedule of the said Order of 2000.

5. ANY provisions contained in the said the Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places, One Way Traffic, Prohibition of Through Traffic, Pedestrian Areas, Weight Restrictions and Protection of Bus Stop) Order 2000 and inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby revoked.

6. THIS Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of February 2006 and may be cited as "THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (LAYTON ROAD) (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2005".

FIRST SCHEDULE

ONE WAY STREET (North to South)

That part of Layton Road from its junction with Collingwood Avenue/Brierly Avenue for a distance of 22m in a south easterly direction (outside 89 to 95 Layton Road)

SECOND SCHEDULE

ACCESS FOR BUSES ONLY

That part of Layton Road from its junction with Collingwood Avenue/Brierly Avenue for a distance of 22m in a south easterly direction (outside 89 to 95 Layton Road)
