## BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS) (PEDESTRIAN AREA) No.2 ORDER 2005

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

<u>1. THIS</u> Order shall come into operation on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April 2006 and may be cited as 'THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROAD) (PEDESTRIAN AREA) No.2 ORDER 2005'

<u>2.</u> IN this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them respectively, that is to say:-

"emergency service" means The Fire and Rescue Service, Police, Ambulance, Coastguard and RNLI.

"vehicle" means a motor vehicle.

<u>3.</u> <u>SAVE</u> as provided in Articles 4 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to enter or proceed at any time in the lengths of road described in the First Schedule to this Order

4. NOTHING in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any of the lengths of road referred to in the First Schedule of this Order for so long as may be necessary:-

- (a) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths or road so referred to or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths or road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (b) if the vehicle is being used for the purposes of an emergency service or any vehicle in the service of a local authority being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties:
- (c) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond their control or owing to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid accident;
- (d) if the vehicle is taking part in any authorised official special event or any television or film crew approved by Blackpool Borough Council; and
- (e) if the vehicle is displaying a valid permit issued by the Local Authority which permits the vehicle to enter and proceed in the areas specified in the First Schedule of this Order.

<u>5. THE</u> provisions contained in THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS) (PEDESTRIAN AREA) ORDER 2005 are hereby revoked so far as the lengths of road described in the Second Schedule to this Order are concerned.

6. <u>SAVE</u> as hereby expressly revoked the provisions of the said Order of 2005 remain in full force and effect.

NEW SOUTH PROMENADE WALK – West of the Tramway – Full length – All areas PROMENADE WALK – West of the Tramway – At Burlington Road West to a point 44m south of the southern boundary of South Pier – All areas

NEW SOUTH PROMENADE – West of the Tramway, the section that is known as the New South Promenade Walk – Full length – All areas

PROMENADE – West of the Tramway, the section that is known as the Promenade Walk at Burlington Road West to a point 44m south of the southern boundary of South Pier – All areas
