# THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS) (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2006

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984 and in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Act 1991 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Borough of Blackpool) Order 2003 (Statutory Instrument No 2677) and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. IN this Order:-

"delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods include checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"goods" includes postal packets of any description;

"parking attendant" means a parking attendant as defined in section 63A of the Act of 1984 (which is inserted by Section 44(1) of the 1991 Act).

penalty charge" and "reduced penalty charge" means a charge set by the Council under the provisions of Section 66 of the 1991 Act and with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport which is to be paid to the council within 28 days beginning with the date of the notice or 14 days in the case of a reduced penalty charge following the issue of a penalty charge notice.

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued or served by a parking attendant pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 of the 1991 Act containing the particulars therein required.

"vehicle" shall not be taken to include non-motor vehicles.

2. THE Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places, Residents Parking Places and Protection of Bus Stops) Order 2003 shall have effect as though the provisions contained in the First, Third and Seventh Schedules to this Order were contained in and formed part of Part 1 of the Second Schedule to the said Order of 2003.

<u>3. THE</u> said Order of 2003 shall be in force and effect as if the above provisions had originally formed part thereof

<u>4. THE</u> provisions relating to No Waiting At Any Time contained in the said Order of 2003 are hereby revoked so far as the length of road and the times specified in the Eighth Schedule to this Order are concerned.

<u>5. THE</u> provisions of The Borough of Blackpool Doctor Parking Place) (Glastonbury Avenue) (Amendment) Order are hereby revoked so far as the roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order are concerned.

<u>6.</u> <u>SAVE</u> as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to wait in the length of road described in the Fourth Schedule to this Order other than:

- (a) for the purpose of delivering or loading or unloading goods to adjacent premises
- (b) to allow passengers to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom his personal luggage

7. NOTHING in Article 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to in the Fourth Schedule of this Order for as long as may be necessary:-

- (a) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the length of road referred to, or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said length of road or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (b) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid accident;
- (c) the vehicle is being used for fire brigade, ambulance, or police purposes, or (not being a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting.

(a) IF a vehicle is left or abandoned in a length of road to which the provisions of Article 6 of this Order applies, in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable and the vehicle may also be removed from that location.

(b) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable a penalty charge notice showing the information required by Section 66(3) of the 1991 Act may then be issued by a parking attendant in accordance with Section 66(1) of the 1991 Act.

(c) Where a parking attendant has removed or caused to be removed a vehicle in accordance with paragraph (a) of this Article

(i) he shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle; (ii) the Council shall be entitled to recover from the person responsible such charges in respect of the removal, storage and disposal of the vehicle as it might prescribe from time to time; (iii) the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended shall apply to the disposal of any such vehicle removed by or on behalf of the Council pursuant to this Article.

<u>9.</u><u>NOTWITHSTANDING</u> the provisions of this Order, the Council may at its discretion (including requiring an administration fee) issue a dispensation allowing a specific vehicle to wait in a length of road, to which Article 6 of this Order applies during the hours of operation of any restriction or prohibition to the contrary.

<u>10.</u> THE provisions relating to Pay and Display contained in The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads)(Various Restrictions) No 6 Order 2003 are hereby revoked so far as the length of road specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order is concerned and the provisions relating to No Waiting At Any Time contained in The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads)(Various Restrictions) No 6 Order 2003 are hereby revoked so far as the length of road and the times specified in the Sixth Schedule to this Order are concerned.

<u>11.</u> <u>THE</u> provisions relating to Pay and Display parking contained in The Borough of Blackpool (Town Centre) (Various Restrictions) Order 2004 are hereby revoked so far as the length of road and the times and charges specified in the Ninth Schedule to this Order are concerned.

<u>12.</u> <u>ANY</u> provisions contained in the Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places, Residents Parking Places and Protection of Bus Stops) Order 2003 and inconsistent with Articles 2, 6 and 7 of this Order are hereby revoked.

<u>13.</u> <u>THIS</u> Order shall come into operation on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 2006 and may be cited as

"THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS) (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2006".
