

**THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (LAYTON DISTRICT CENTRE) (VARIOUS  
RESTRICTIONS) AND (REVOCATION) ORDER 2007**

---

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984 and in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Act 1991 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Borough of Blackpool) Order 2003 (Statutory Instrument No 2677) and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. IN this order, except where the content otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them, respectfully, that is to say:-

"delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods include checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"goods" includes postal packets of any description;

"parking attendant" means a parking attendant as defined in section 63A of the Act of 1984 (which is inserted by Section 44(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1991 ("the 1991 Act"))

"penalty charge" and "reduced penalty charge" means a charge set by the Council under the provisions of Section 66 of the 1991 Act and with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport which is to be paid to the council within 28 days beginning with the date of the notice or 14 days in the case of a reduced penalty charge following the issue of a penalty charge notice.

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued or served by a parking attendant pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 of the 1991 Act containing the particulars therein required.

"vehicle" shall not be taken to include non-motor vehicles

2. THE Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places, Residents' Parking Places and Protection of Bus Stops) Order 2003 shall have effect as though the provisions contained in the First Schedule to this Order were contained in and formed part of the Second Schedule, Part I, to the said Order of 2003.

3. THE Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places, Residents' Parking Places and Protection of Bus Stops) Order 2003 shall have effect as though the provisions contained in the Second Schedule to this Order were contained in and formed part of the Second Schedule, Part I, to the said Order of 2003.

4. THE said Order of 2003 shall be in full force and effect as if the above provisions had originally formed part thereof.

5. SAVE as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time for the purpose of loading or unloading in any length of road referred to in the Third Schedule of this Order.

6. NOTHING in Article 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to wait if

- (a) the waiting is only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage;
- (b) the vehicle is being used for emergency Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- (c) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control, or the driver has been told to wait by a police constable in uniform, or such waiting is necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (d) the vehicle is being used in connection with any building or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths or road so referred to or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths or road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984 and it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road;
- (e) the vehicle, not being a passenger carrying vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
- (f) the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Post Office and is waiting in any affected length or road whilst postal packets, as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953, addressed to premises adjacent to that length or road are being



unloaded from any vehicle or having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to that length or road;

- (g) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary while a gate or barrier is opened or closed to allow access or departure to or from adjacent premises;

7. SAVE as provided in Article 8 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any length of road referred to in the Fourth Schedule of this Order during the times specified therein in relation to that length of road other than:

- (a) for the purpose of delivering or loading or unloading goods to adjacent premises
- (b) to allow a passenger or passengers to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom his or their personal luggage

8. NOTHING in Article 9 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in the Fourth Schedule of this Order if: for so long as may be necessary:-

- (a) the waiting is only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage;
- (b) the vehicle is being used for emergency Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- (c) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control, or the driver has been told to wait by a police constable in uniform, or such waiting is necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (d) the vehicle is being used in connection with any building or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths or road so referred to or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths or road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984 and it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road;
- (e) the vehicle, not being a passenger carrying vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;

- (f) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling-house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.
- (g) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary while a gate or barrier is opened or closed to allow access or departure to or from adjacent premises;

9. THE Borough of Blackpool (Various locations) (Consolidation of Taxis Stands) Order 2006 shall have effect as though the provisions contained in the Fifth Schedule to this Order were contained in and formed part of the First Schedule, to the said Order of 2006.

10. THE Borough of Blackpool (Various locations) (Consolidation of Taxis Stands) Order 2006 shall have effect as though the provisions contained in the Sixth Schedule to this Order were contained in and formed part of the First Schedule to the said Order of 2006.

11. THE provisions relating to no waiting at any time contained in The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places, Residents' Parking Places and Protection of Bus Stops) Order 2003 are hereby revoked so far as the lengths of road referred to in the Seventh and Eighth Schedules to this Order are concerned.

12. THE provisions relating to Stands available for hackney carriages horse drawn or propelled by mechanical power and Clearway (No stopping) – 24 hours contained in The Borough of Blackpool Various locations Consolidation of Taxis Stands Order 2006 are hereby revoked so far as the length of road referred to in the Ninth Schedule to this Order is concerned.

13. THE provisions relating to Stands available for hackney carriages horse drawn or propelled by mechanical power and Clearway (No stopping) – 8pm to 3am contained in The Borough of Blackpool Various locations Consolidation of Taxis Stands Order 2006 are hereby revoked so far as the length of road referred to in the Tenth Schedule to this Order is concerned.

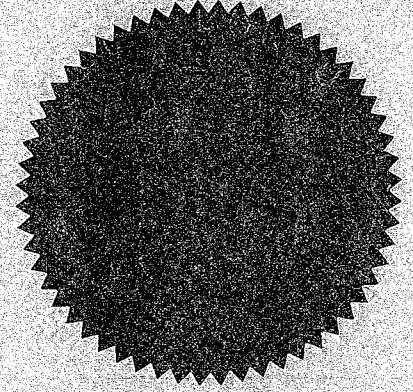

- ONSLow ROAD - From a point 19m east of the easterly kerb line of Westcliffe Drive for a distance of 3m in an easterly direction – South side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From a point 13m north of the northerly kerb line of Norwood Avenue to a point 32m north of the northerly kerb line of Onslow Road – East side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From a point 12m north of the northerly kerb line of Onslow Road for a distance of 2m in a northerly direction – East side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From the southerly kerb line of Onslow Road for a distance of 4m in a southerly direction – East side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From the northerly kerb line of Huntley Avenue for a distance of 3m in a northerly direction – East side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From the southerly kerb line of Huntley Avenue for a distance of 9m in a southerly direction – East side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From a point 38m north of the northerly kerb line of Grenfell Avenue for a distance of 2m in a northerly direction – East side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From the northerly kerb line of Grenfell Avenue for a distance of 7m in a northerly direction – East side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From the southerly kerb line of Grenfell Avenue for a distance of 5m in a southerly direction – East side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From the northerly kerb line of Grange Road for a distance of 9m in a northerly direction – East side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From a point 28m south of the southerly kerb line of Annesley Avenue to a point 11m north of the northerly kerb line of Annesley Avenue – West side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From a point 42m north of the northerly kerb line of Annesley Avenue for a distance of 2m in a northerly direction – West side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From a point 42m south of the southerly kerb line of Granby Avenue for a distance of 2m in a southerly direction – West side
- WESTCLIFFE DRIVE – From a point 16m south of the southerly kerb line of Granby Avenue to a point 46m north of the northerly kerb line of Granby Avenue – West side
