<u>1. NO</u> person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in the said Schedule.

<u>2. THIS</u> Order shall come into operation on the 15<sup>th</sup> October 2007 and may be cited as "THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (LANGFIELD AVENUE) (ONE WAY) ORDER 2007"
