

3. The provisions relating to no stopping between the hours of 8.00 am and 5.00 pm on Mondays to Fridays on the school entrance markings contained in The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Various Restrictions) No 2 Order 2004 are hereby revoked so far as the lengths of road and the times specified in the Second Schedule to this Order are concerned.

4. SAVE as are hereby expressly revoked the provisions of The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Various Restrictions) No 2 Order 2004 remain in full force and effect.

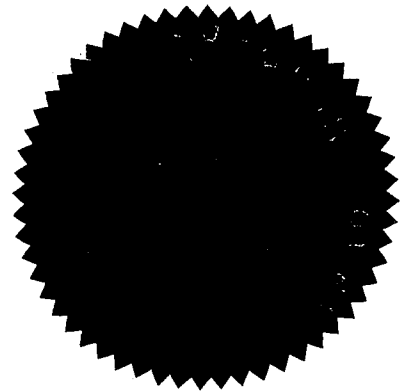
5. ANY provisions contained in said Order of 2003 and inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby revoked.

THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS) (SCHOOL ENTRANCE
MARKINGS) AND (REVOCATION) ORDER 2006

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 and Part IV of the Ninth Schedule of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "1984 Act") and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act of 1984 and of all other powers them enabling hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop on school entrance markings on a length road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order between the hours of 8am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) from 1st September to 15th July (inclusive) in any year.

2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to stop on school entrance markings on a length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order-

- a. the vehicle is being used for emergency Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- b. the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control, or the driver has been told to wait by a police constable in uniform, or such waiting is necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- c. the vehicle, not being a passenger carrying vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
- d. the vehicle is being used in connection with any building or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths or road so referred to or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths or road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984 and it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road;

FIRST SCHEDULE

NO STOPPING 1ST SEPTEMBER TO 15TH JULY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8 AM TO 4 PM ON MONDAYS TO FRIDAYS ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS

MEYLER AVENUE – from a point 36.4m south of the southern kerbline of Brooklyn Avenue for a distance of 24.8m south – East side

LYNWOOD AVENUE – from a point 123m east of the easterly kerbline of Westcliffe Drive for a distance of 62.5m east – North side

SECOND SCHEDULE

REVOCATION OF NO STOPPING BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8 AM TO 5 PM ON MONDAYS TO FRIDAYS ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS

LANGDALE ROAD – north side – from a point 6m west of Lindbeck Road for a distance of 31m in a westerly direction.

LANGDALE ROAD – north side – from a point 3m west of Tarnside for a distance of 57m in a westerly direction.
