BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL (CROSSLAND ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2008

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

<u>1. THE</u> Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places, One-way traffic, Prohibition of Through Traffic, Pedestrian Areas, Weight Restrictions, Width Restrictions, and Protection of Bus Stops) Order 2000 shall have effect as though the provisions contained in the Schedule to this order were contained in and formed part of Article 21 to the said order of 2000.

<u>2. THE</u> said Order of 2000 shall be in full force and effect as if the above provisions had originally formed part thereof.

<u>3.</u> ANY provisions contained in the said Order of 2000 and inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby revoked.

<u>4. THIS</u> Order shall come into operation on the 12th day of November 2008 and may be cited as "BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL (CROSSLAND ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2008"
