THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS)

(VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2009

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984 and in exercise of its powers under the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Borough of Blackpool) Order 2003 (Statutory Instrument No 2677) and of all other enabling powers made the following Order:-

<u>1.</u> IN this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them respectively, that is to say:-

"emergency service" means The Fire and Rescue Service, Police, Ambulance Service, Coastguard Service and the Royal National Lifeboat Institution.

"relevant position" means

- (a) on the dashboard or facia of the vehicle so that the front of the permit is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; or
- (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or facia in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the front of the permit is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle or
- (c) on the handlebars where the vehicle is a bicycle or tricycle

"valid permit" means a permit that has been issued by the Council that permits waiting or loading and unloading under Articles 5 or 6 of this Order that has not ceased to be in force.

"vehicle" means a motor vehicle.

<u>2.</u> <u>SAVE</u> as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule to this Order.

<u>3.</u> <u>SAVE</u> as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order for the purpose of loading or unloading.

<u>4.</u> NOTHING in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in the First and Second Schedules of this Order for so long as may be necessary: -

- (a) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths or road so referred to or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths or road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (b) if the vehicle is an emergency services vehicle or any vehicle in the service of the Council being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond their control or owing to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid accident: or

(d) if the vehicle is taking part in any authorised official special event or any television or film crew approved by the Council.

<u>5. NOTHING</u> in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle that displays in the relevant position a valid permit issued by the Council to wait

- (i) on the Lower Walk at Gynn Square when it is being used for the purpose of essential services or loading and unloading the Hole in the Wall Café or
- (ii) within the Boating Pool area or adjacent to the Boating Pool on the Lower Walk when it is being used for the purpose of essential services or loading and unloading at the Boating Pool

<u>6. NOTHING</u> in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid permit issued by the Council to wait for a maximum period of 15 minutes on

(i) the section of the pedestrianised area of Princes Way west of the westerly kerb line of the carriageway from the Lower Walk Access (at Little Bispham) for a distance of 40m in a northerly direction or

(ii) the Lower Walk (western side) from Princes Way for a distance of 66m in a southerly direction,

when it is being used for the purpose of unhitching or attaching a boat and trailer, for use in connection with The Fylde Boat and Angling Club PROVIDED THAT no vehicle shall return for a further period of waiting under the terms of this Article when a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of a previous period of waiting of the same vehicle under the terms of this Article.

7. NOTWITHSTANDING any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, the Council may at its discretion (including requiring an administration fee) issue a dispensation allowing a specific vehicle to wait in a length of road specified in the First and Second Schedules to this Order.

8. THIS Order shall come into operation on the 2nd day of July 2009 and may be cited as "THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (VARIOUS ROADS) (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2009".
