THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (AUTUMN ILLUMINATIONS - RESTRICTION ON MOVEMENT OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2009

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereinafter called "the Council" in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Act 1991 (heinafter referred to as the "1991 Act") and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Borough of Blackpool) Order 2003 (Statutory Instrument No 2677) and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order:

"civil enforcement officer" means a civil enforcement officer as defined in Section 76 of the Traffic management Act 2004

".penalty charge" means the charge imposed under legislation in respect of contraventions that are subject to civil enforcement

'switch off time of the Illuminations' means the time specified in the fourth column of Schedule 1 to this Order for the date and day specified in relation thereto in the first and second columns of the said Schedule 1

"switch on time of the Illuminations' means the time specified in the third column of Schedule 1 to this Order for the date and day specified in relation thereto in the first and second columns of the said Schedule 1

- 2. No person on the days and during the times specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall drive or cause to be driven in any direction any horse-drawn carriage designed or constructed for the carrying of passengers into or on the carriage drive of the length of Promenade, Blackpool, between Squires Gate Lane (in the south) and Red Bank Road (in the north).
- 3. No person on the days and during the times specified in Schedule 3 to this Order shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle onto the Promenade from the following roads:-Waterloo Road, Station Road, Balmoral Road, Watson Road, Clifton Drive, Burlington Road West, Wimbourne Place, Harrowside West, Harrow Place, Cardigan Place, Abercorn Place and Freemantle Avenue. This prohibition shall apply whenever indicated by signage or a Police Officer in uniform.
- 4. No person on the days and during the times specified in Schedule 3 to this Order shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle in a southerly direction along Queens Promenade between Pennystone Road and Red Bank Road. from 15 minutes before Switch-On Time of the Illuminations until 15 minutes after Switch-Off Time of the Illuminations during the period 4th September to 8th November 2009 (inclusive). This prohibition shall be apply whenever indicated by signage or a Police Officer in uniform.
- 5. No person on the days and during the times specified in Schedule 4 to this Order shall cause hackney carriages to stop on authorised hackney carriage stands on either side of that length of Promenade that lies between its junction with Burlington Road West and Lytham Road (Manchester Square).
- 6 No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in a northbound direction on Queens Promenade to turn right into Red Bank Road during the period 4th September to 8th November 2009 (inclusive). This prohibition shall apply whenever indicated by signage or a Police Officer in uniform.

- 7. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in a eastbound direction on the unnamed road leading from Starr Gate Car Park and Light Craft Club to turn left on to Starr Gate / New South Promenade during the period 4th September to 8th November 2009 (inclusive). This prohibition shall apply whenever indicated by signage or a Police Officer in uniform.
- 8 If a hackney carriage is left or abandoned in a hackney carriage stand to which any provision of this Order applies in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order a penalty charge shall be payable and/or the hackney carriage may be removed from that location.

<u>THIS</u> Order shall come into operation on the fourth day of September 2009 and continue in force until the eighth day of November 2009 and may be cited as "THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (AUTUMN ILLUMINATIONS – RESTRICTION ON MOVEMENT OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2009".
