# THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (WHITEGATE DRIVE) (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) AND (REVOCATIONS) ORDER 2011

The Council of the Borough of Blackpool (hereafter referred to as 'the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 46A, 47, 49, 53 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Act 1991, Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Borough of Blackpool) Order 2003 (Statutory Instrument No 2677) and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. IN this Order, except where the context otherwise requires the following words or expressions shall have the meaning assigned to them, respectively that is to say:-

"a person authorised by the Council" means a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.

"Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person authorised by the Council to supervise any parking place.

"disabled person's badge" shall have the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended by the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2000 that has not ceased to be in force.

"disabled persons parking disc" means a device which:-

- a) is 125 millimetres square and coloured blue;
- b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid; and
- c) is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period has begun as described in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.

"disabled persons vehicle" means a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge in accordance with the circumstances prescribed in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended.

"goods" includes postal packets of any description.

"invalid carriage" means the same as in Section 136 (5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

"licensed hackney carriage vehicle" means a mechanically propelled hackney carriage licensed under the provisions of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued or served by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 containing the provisions therein required.

"relevant position" shall have the following meanings:-

- (a) on the dashboard or facia of the vehicle so that the font of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; or
- (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or facia in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; or
- (c) on the windscreen so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; and
- (d) in each case for the avoidance of doubt so that no letter, numeral or symbol on the front of the badge is obscured.

'servicing' means the conveyance of equipment, goods or merchandise to or from a premise or for carrying out maintenance works to a premise.

"taxi rank days" means the days specified in the second column of Schedule 5 and 6 hereto in relation to a length of road specified therein

"taxi rank hours" means the hours specified in the third column of Schedule 5 and 6 hereto in relation to a length of road specified therein

"Universal Service Provider" shall have the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

"vehicle" shall not be taken to include non-motor vehicles.

- 2. SAVE as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person except under the direction or with the permission of a person authorised by the Council shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 3. NOTHING in Article 2 of this Order shall render in unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified therein if:-
- (a) the waiting is only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage;
  - (b) the vehicle is being used for emergency Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purposes;

- (c) the vehicle, not being a passenger carrying vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (e) the vehicle is bearing a livery which is used by a Universal Service Provider and the vehicle is engaged in the collection and/or delivery of letters in accordance with statutory duty for the provision of services for the conveyance of letters;
- (f) if the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary while a gate or barrier is opened or closed to allow access or departure to or from adjacent premises;
- (g) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control, or the driver has been told to wait by a police constable in uniform, or such waiting is necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- 4. (a) SAVE as provided in Article 4 (b) of this Order no person other than a person authorised by the Council shall cause or permit any vehicle (which in this Article includes a horse drawn vehicle) other than a mechanically propelled taxi to stop in a length of road listed in Schedule 2 or Schedule 3 of this Order during the taxi rank hours on the taxi rank days specified therein.
- 4. (b) NOTHING in Article 4 (a) of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a length of road listed in Schedule 5 or Schedule 6 of this Order during the taxi rank hours on the taxi rank days specified therein if:-
- (a) the waiting is only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage;
  - (b) the vehicle is being used for emergency Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- (c) the vehicle, not being a passenger carrying vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads or any sewer or of any main, pipe or

apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (e) the vehicle is bearing a livery which is used by a Universal Service Provider and the vehicle is engaged in the collection and/or delivery of letters in accordance with statutory duty for the provision of services for the conveyance of letters;
- (f) if the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary while a gate or barrier is opened or closed to allow access or departure to or from adjacent premises;
- (g) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control, or the driver has been told to wait by a police constable in uniform, or such waiting is necessary in order to avoid an accident.
- 5. SAVE as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person except under the direction or with the permission of a person authorised by the Council shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any the length of road specified in Schedule 4 of this Order during the times specified therein other than:
  - (a) for the purpose of delivering or loading or unloading goods to adjacent premises.
- (b) to allow a passenger or passengers to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom his or their personal luggage.
- 6. NOTHING in Article 5 of this Order shall render in unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified therein if:-
- (a) the waiting is only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage;
  - (b) the vehicle is being used for emergency Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- (c) the vehicle, not being a passenger carrying vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (e) the vehicle is bearing a livery which is used by a Universal Service Provider and the vehicle is engaged in the collection and/or delivery of letters in accordance with statutory duty for the provision of services for the conveyance of letters;
- (f) if the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary while a gate or barrier is opened or closed to allow access or departure to or from adjacent premises;

(g) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances
beyond his control, or the driver has been told to wait by a police constable in uniform, or such waiting is
necessary in order to avoid an accident;

of a person authorised by the Council shall cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload at any time in any of
the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 of this Order.
8. NOTHING in Article 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to load and unload at any time
in the lengths of road specified therein in:-
(a) the vehicle is being used for emergency Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purposes;
(b) the vehicle, not being a passenger carrying vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority
in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such
powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
(c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be
used in connection with any building or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the
maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection
or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads or any sewer or of any main, pipe or
apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1)
of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
(d) the vehicle is bearing a livery which is used by a Universal Service Provider and the vehicle is
engaged in the collection and/or delivery of letters in accordance with statutory duty for the provision of
services for the conveyance of letters;
(e) if the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary while a gate or barrier is
opened or closed to allow access or departure to or from adjacent premises;
(f) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances
beyond his control, or the driver has been told to wait by a police constable in uniform, or such waiting is
necessary in order to avoid an accident;

9. (a) SAVE as provided in Article 10 or Article 9(b) of this Order no person except under the direction or
with the permission of a person authorised by the Council shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of
the lengths of road specified in Schedule 6 of this Order on the days and during the times specified therein.

9. (b) NOTWITHSTANDING the provisions contained in Article 9(a) or Article 10 of this Order, nothing
therein shall prevent a vehicle from waiting for a maximum period of 60 minutes in the length of road referred
to in Schedule 6 of this Order between the hours and on the days specified therein provided that a period of at

least 2 hours has elapsed since the termination of a previous period of waiting by the same coach in the same length of road.

- 10. NOTHING in Article 9 of this Order shall render in unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified therein if:-
- (a) the waiting is only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage;
  - (b) the vehicle is being used for emergency Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- (c) the vehicle, not being a passenger carrying vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting;
- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection or alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraph apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Second Schedule to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (e) the vehicle is bearing a livery which is used by a Universal Service Provider and the vehicle is engaged in the collection and/or delivery of letters in accordance with statutory duty for the provision of services for the conveyance of letters;
- (f) if the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary while a gate or barrier is opened or closed to allow access or departure to or from adjacent premises;
- (g) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control, or the driver has been told to wait by a police constable in uniform, or such waiting is necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- 11. (a) THE provisions contained in Schedule 7 of this Order are hereby revoked so far only as the restrictions on the lengths of road specified therein are concerned.
- 11. (b) SAVE as provided in Article 11(a) the Orders referred too therein shall remain in full force and effect.
- 12. IF a vehicle is left or abandoned in a length of road or in any other location whatsoever to which any provision of this Order applies in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order a Civil Enforcement Officer may issue a penalty charge notice and/or the vehicle may be removed from that location.

13.	NOTWITHSTANDING any	of the foregoing provisions of this Order a Civil Enforcement Officer on
behalf	of the Council may at their d	scretion (including requiring an administration fee) issue a dispensation
allowir	ng a specific vehicle to wait in	a length of road or any other location whatsoever to which any provision of
this Or	der applies during the hours	of operation of any restriction or prohibition to the contrary.

14. THIS Order shall come into operation on the nineteenth day of September 2011 and may be cited as "THE BOROUGH OF BLACKPOOL (WHITEGATE DRIVE) (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) AND (REVOCATIONS) ORDER 2011"
