**THE POOLE (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT)  
(HERBERT AVENUE) (AMENDMENT NUMBER 115) ORDER 2014**

The Council of the Borough and County of the Town of Poole, the Highway Authority in exercise of its power under Section 1(1), 1(3), 1(3A), 2(1), 4(1), 4(2), 4(3), 5, 32, 35, 35A, 36, 47, 49, 53, 63A, 65, 66 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (herein under referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

1. The Poole (Various Roads and Parking Places) (Consolidation of Orders made for the Regulation of On and Off-Street Parking Places) Order No.11 be amended as follows:

**A. The following shall be added to Schedule No. 7.14 (On Street Parking Place Disabled Persons Parking Only) to the Order:**

i	Herbert Avenue	northern side	from the boundary of No. 141	for a distance of 6.6 metres in a north-easterly direction
