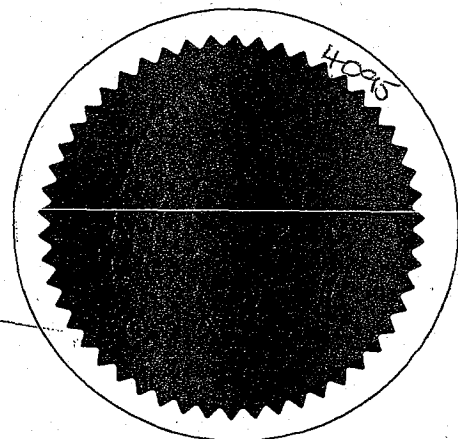
The Council of the Borough of Bournemouth ("the Council"),

- in exercise of its powers under the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders(Procedure)(England and Wales) Regulations 1996 ("the regulation") and of all other enabling powers, and
 - after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police,
- hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Borough of Bournemouth (Parking Regulation Orders)(Consolidation) Order 2004 is hereby varied by;
 - a) The deletion from the Schedules thereto of the items contained in Schedule 1 to this Order;
 - b) The addition to Schedules thereto of the items contained in Schedule 2 to this Order.
2. The Borough of Bournemouth (Parking Regulation Orders)(Consolidation) Order 2004 as varied on divers dates and save as expressly varied as aforesaid shall continue in full force and effect.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 11th March 2005 and may be cited as: THE BOROUGH OF BOURNEMOUTH (PARKING REGULATION ORDER) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2004 (VARIATION) (NO.1) ORDER 2005
