PART I

DEFINITIONS, COMMENCEMENT AND REVOCATION

1.0 DEFINITIONS

1.1 In Parts II and III of this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions shall have the following meanings:

1.1.1 “**Approved**” means approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment

1.1.2 “**Authorised Cab Rank**” means an area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002

1.1.3 “**Authorised Vehicle**” means a vehicle specified in Column (3) of Part I of the Schedule and shall include electrically propelled vehicles intended or adapted for use on roads

1.1.4 “**Bus Stop**” means an area on a highway which is bounded by a marking shown on diagram 1025 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002

1.1.5 “**Caravan**” is as defined in Section 29 of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960

1.1.6 “**Coach**” means a vehicle adapted to carrying more than 18 passengers exclusive of the driver

1.1.7 “**Collecting**” and “**Delivering**” in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their collection or delivery

1.1.8 “**Disabled Driver**” means (i) any person driving an invalid carriage or (ii) any person driving an unauthorised vehicle displaying a badge issued in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended

- 1.1.9 **“Disabled Person”** means a disabled person of a description prescribed by Regulation 4 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended
- 1.1.10 **“Disabled Persons Badge”** has the same meaning as in Regulation 11 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended
- 1.1.11 **“Disabled Persons Parking Disc”** should be displayed as described in the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended
- 1.1.12 **“Disabled Persons Vehicle”** has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended
- 1.1.13 **“Driver”** in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the said vehicle or responsible for the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place. The registered keeper of the said vehicle shall be deemed to have been the driver unless evidence to the contrary is shown
- 1.1.14 **“Goods Vehicle”** means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the conveyance of goods or burden the gross weight of which is between 3500kg and 7.5 tonnes
- 1.1.15 **“Hackney Carriage”** has the same meaning as in Section 38 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847
- 1.1.16 **“Hackney Carriage Stand”** means any area of the carriageway of a specified road intended for the waiting of hackney carriages which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002
- 1.1.17 **“Heavy Commercial Vehicle”** is as defined in Section 138 of the Act
- 1.1.18 **“Invalid Carriage”** is as defined by Section 136(5) of the Act
- 1.1.19 **“Motor Car”** is as defined in Section 136(2)(a) of the Act
- 1.1.20 **“No Loading Orders”** means any Orders made by the Council or its predecessors in relation to restrictions on loading and unloading on roads within the administrative area of the Borough of Christchurch

- 1.1.21 **“No Waiting Orders”** means any Orders made by the Council or its predecessors in relation to restrictions on waiting on roads within the administrative area of the Borough of Christchurch
- 1.1.22 **“Off-Street Plans”** means the plans annexed to this Order headed “Off-Street” Plans
- 1.1.23 **“On-Street Plans”** means the plans annexed to this Order headed ‘On-Street Plans’
- 1.1.24 **“Owner”** means the person by whom the vehicle is kept and used and in determining for the purposes of this Order who was the owner of the vehicle at the time it shall be presumed that the owner was the person in whose name the vehicle was at that time registered under the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 and where the vehicle is the subject of a hiring agreement or hire purchase agreement “owner” includes the person entitled to possession of the vehicle under the agreement
- 1.1.25 **“Owner of Business Premises”** means a person who is the sole proprietor or partner of business premises situated in the Borough of Christchurch but excluding Company Shareholders
- 1.1.26 **“Parking Attendant”** means any person duly authorised by or on behalf of the Council or Police Constable in uniform to supervise the parking place
- 1.1.27 **“Parking Bay”** means the part of the parking place marked out for the leaving of an authorised vehicle
- 1.1.28 **“Parking Disc”** means a disc issued by a local authority complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No 4631:70), and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins
- 1.1.29 **“Parking Place”** means any area of land specified by name in Column (1) of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule and more particularly shown on the Off-Street Plans hereinafter defined for use as a parking place
- 1.1.30 **“Passenger Vehicle”** means a vehicle adapted to carry more than 8 passengers exclusive of the driver
- 1.1.31 **“Public Service Vehicle”** has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981

- 1.1.32 **“Public Service Vehicle Orders”** means any Orders made by the Council or its predecessors in relation to restrictions on roads within the administrative area of the Borough of Christchurch relating to public service vehicles, hackney carriage vehicles and taxis
- 1.1.33 **“Resident of the Borough”** means a person who is resident within the Borough of Christchurch and whose name would normally appear on the Electoral Register prepared for the said Borough
- 1.1.34 **“Season Ticket”** and **“Parking Permit”** means a ticket or permit issued in accordance with the provisions of Part III of this Order
- 1.1.35 **“Taxi”** means a licensed taxi as described in Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and licensed hire car as licensed under Section 48 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976
- 1.1.36 **“Ticket Machine”** means an apparatus of an approved type and design being an apparatus designed to issue parking tickets indicating the payment of a charge and the day and time at which the charge was paid
- 1.1.37 **“Trailer”** includes a caravan and means a vehicle drawn by a motor vehicle

1.2 **Further Provisions relating to Interpretation relating to On-Street and Off-Street Parking**

- 1.2.1 For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a Disabled Person’s Badge in the relevant position when and only when:-
- (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part I of the badge is legible from the outside of the vehicle; or
 - (ii) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel the parking disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from the outside of the vehicle;
 - (iii) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted the parking disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle

1.2.2 For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be deemed to wait if for more than two minutes in the same place any one part of the road is below any part of the vehicle or its load (if any) throughout the period exceeding two minutes whether or not the vehicle is moved during the period.

1.3 Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of the Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament

2.0 COMMENCEMENT

2.1 This Order shall come into operation on the Fourteenth day of May of the year Two Thousand and Four

2.2 The restrictions imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or any other enactment.

3.0 REVOCATION

3.1 The Borough of Christchurch (Various Roads and Parking Places) (Consolidation of Orders made for On and Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2003 is revoked from the Commencement Date

3.2 All previous variation and amendment orders made by the Council in respect of on and off-street parking places specified in the Schedules to this Order are hereby revoked from the Commencement Date

1.0 WAITING RESTRICTIONS

1.1 No Waiting at Any Time

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the First Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.2 No Waiting 01 May to 30 September at Any Time

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time from 01 May to 30 September inclusive in any year on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.3 No Waiting 01 April to 30 September 10.00 am to 7.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time from 01 April to 30 September inclusive in any year between the hours of 10.00 am to 7.00 pm on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Third Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.4 No Waiting 01 April to 30 September 10.00 pm to 7.00 am

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time from 01 April to 30 September inclusive in any year between the hours of 10.00 pm to 7.00 am on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.5 No Waiting 10.00 am to 6.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 10.00 am to 6.00 pm in any year on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.6 No Waiting 10.00 am to 7.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 10.00 am to 7.00 pm on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Sixth Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.7 No Waiting 8.00 am to 6.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 8.00 am to 6.00 pm on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Seventh Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.8 No Waiting 9.00 am to 5.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 9.00 am to 5.00 pm on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Eighth Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.9 No Waiting 9.00 am to 6.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 9.00 am to 6.00 pm on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Ninth Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.10 No Waiting 9.00 am to 7.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 9.00 am to 7.00 pm on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Tenth Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.11 No Waiting Monday to Friday 10.00 am to 4.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 10.00 am to 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Eleventh Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.12 No Waiting Monday to Friday 10.00 am to 6.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 10.00 am to 6.00 pm on Monday to Friday on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Twelfth Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.13 No Waiting Monday to Friday 8.30 am to 4.30 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 8.30 am to 4.30 pm on Monday to Friday on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Thirteenth Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.14 No Waiting Monday to Friday 8.00 am to 6.00 pm

Save as provided in Articles 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Parking Attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 8.00 am to 6.00 pm on Monday to Friday on the roads or sides of the roads specified in the Fourteenth Schedule to this Order in the areas identified on the On-Street Plans annexed to this Order

1.15 No Waiting Monday to Saturday 10.00 am to 6.00 pm

- 4.12 Nothing in Article 2.6 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the roads specified in the Fifty-Third Schedule to this Order in the areas shown marked on the On-Street Plans for the purpose of loading or unloading goods to or from a vehicle in relation to commercial vehicles to 45 – 67 (inclusive) odds, and 46 – 76 (inclusive) evens, High Street only between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm
- 4.13 Nothing in Article 3.2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Hackney Carriage to wait in the roads specified in the Fifty-Seventh Schedule to this Order in the areas marked on the On-Street Plans

5.0 LIABILITY TO AND AMOUNT OF PENALTY CHARGE

- 5.1 Subject to Article 5.2 the owner of a vehicle shall be liable to pay an amount of Sixty Pounds (£60) (“the penalty charge”) if the vehicle is caused or permitted to wait at any time in any of the roads specified in Schedule One to Fifty-Seven inclusive to this Order in the areas shown marked on the On-Street Plans contrary to any of the Articles in part II of this Order
- 5.2 In the event that the penalty charge is paid before the end of the period of 14 days beginning with the date of the penalty charge notice, the amount of the penalty charge will be reduced to Thirty Pounds (£30)
- 5.3 Where there is a contravention of any of the Articles in Part II of this Order a Parking Attendant shall attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice (“the penalty charge notice”) and also referred to as a “PCN” which shall include the following particulars:-
- (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence the number of trade plate carried by the vehicle
 - (b) the time at which the Parking Attendant observed that the penalty charge had been incurred
 - (c) the grounds on which the Parking Attendant believes that a penalty charge is payable with respect to the vehicle
 - (d) a statement that the penalty charge of Sixty Pounds (£60) is required to be paid
 - (e) that the penalty charge must be paid before the end of the period of 28 days beginning with the date of the penalty charge notice
 - (f) that if the penalty charge is paid before the end of the period of 14 days beginning with the date of the penalty charge notice, the amount of the penalty charge will be reduced to Thirty Pounds (£30)
 - (g) that if the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the 28 day period, a notice to owner may be served by the Council on the person appearing to them to be the owner of the vehicle
 - (h) the address to which payment of the penalty charge must be sent

- 5.4 The penalty charge shall be paid to the Council either by cheque banker's draft money order or postal order which shall be delivered by post or by cash in person to the Council's Resources Department situate at the Civic Offices Bridge Street Christchurch Dorset BH23 1AZ provided that the 28 day period expires upon a day on which the said Department is closed the period within which payment of the penalty charge shall be paid to the Council shall be extended until 1pm on the next full day on which the said Department is open
- 5.5 The period for which a vehicle may be left after the penalty charge has been incurred shall not exceed twelve hours and the driver of the vehicle shall not cause or permit the vehicle to wait for longer than that
- 5.6 If a vehicle is left for more than the period of twelve hours referred to in Article 5.6 after the penalty charge has been incurred it shall be the duty of a Parking Attendant to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a further penalty charge notice which shall include the particulars mentioned in Article 5.3 and the following additional particulars namely the time at which he or she first noticed the vehicle had been left for more than the prescribed period after the penalty charge had been incurred

6.0 USE OF THE PARKING PLACE

- 6.1 Subject to the following provisions of this Order the parking place specified by name in Column (1) of Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule may be used as a parking place for such vehicles but in all cases excluding caravans in such positions on such days during such hours and on payment of such charges as are specified in relation to such parking place in Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule
- 6.2 Where in Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place unless it is of the specified class
- 6.3 The driver of a vehicle shall not (except with the written consent of the Council) permit it to wait in any parking place in such a position that it causes or is likely to cause an obstruction to other users of the parking place or that it is not in accordance with the requirements of this Order
- 6.4 The driver of a vehicle shall not (except with the written consent of the Council) permit it to wait in any parking place in a parking bay or bays marked “Reserved” whether by a word or words painted on the ground or by any notice standing or otherwise displayed adjacent to the parking bay(s)
- 6.5 The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking bay that is marked in words or symbol as only available for the “disabled” unless there is displayed a Disabled Persons Badge only and the disabled person to whom the badge was issued accompanies the vehicle
- 6.6 A vehicle drawing a trailer may wait in the parking place unless there is a sign in the parking place to the contrary but for the purposes of this Order the vehicle and the trailer shall be deemed to be a separate vehicle and the driver of the vehicle shall be deemed to be the driver of the trailer. The provisions of this Order shall apply to a “trailer” as they apply to a “vehicle”

7.0 CLOSURE OF THE PARKING PLACE

Nothing in Article 6.0 shall restrict the power of the Council to close to the public the whole or any part of the parking place either temporarily or permanently

8.0 MAXIMUM PERIOD OF WAITING

8.1 The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking places known as Avon Run Road Southcliffe Road Steamer Point Highcliffe Cliff Top and Highcliffe Castle for longer than twenty four hours continuously between 01 October and 31 March inclusive without the prior written consent of the Council

8.2 Subject to Article 8.1 the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking places called Southcliffe Road Steamer Point and Highcliffe Castle overnight in accordance with times displayed at notice boards at each of these parking places

8.3 Between 01 April and 30 September inclusive the holder of an Annual Season Ticket or Parking Permit shall not permit the vehicle to wait in the Priory Car Park for longer than four hours unless the holder has obtained the prior written consent of the Council

8.4 The driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in the Highcliffe Castle Car Park for longer than four hours without the prior written consent of the Council

9.0 CHARGES

9.1 General

Subject to Article 20.0 the driver of an authorised vehicle shall pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the parking charges specified in Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule provided that

- (a) the charge shall apply whether or not the driver or passenger(s) remains with the vehicle within the parking place
- (b) where in a parking place it is indicated by notice that in respect of any day or any specified part of a day no charge will be made or such lesser charge than that specified in the Schedule will be made then the charge (if any) shall be such lesser charge

10.0 SEASON TICKETS AND PARKING PERMITS

10.1 The Council may on an application of the owner or driver of an authorised vehicle issue a season ticket or parking permit in respect of that authorised vehicle on payment of the charge specified in Part II of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule

10.2 Subject to Article 7.0 a season ticket or parking permit so issued shall be valid in respect of such of the parking places described in Part II of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule as is specified thereof during the period for which it is issued

11.0 METHOD OF PAYMENT OF CHARGES

- 11.1 Subject to Article 11.3 the appropriate charge specified in Part I of Fifty-Eighth Schedule shall be paid by the driver of an authorised vehicle leaving the authorised vehicle in a parking bay within a parking place by the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins into the ticket machine provided and where more coins than one are required they shall be inserted in the ticket machine immediately one after the other
- 11.2 Each parking ticket to be purchased shall be such as may be necessary to show that the whole of the parking charge has been paid which charge is to be ascertained from the information shown on the ticket machine and/or notice board situated in the parking place
- 11.3 Each parking ticket purchased in accordance with this Article in payment of the parking charge as specified in Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule shall be purchased immediately after the vehicle has stopped in the parking place for the purpose of waiting therein. Further tickets in payment of the relevant parking charge for any subsequent period may be purchased at any time before the expiry of the period for which the parking charge has been paid
- 11.4 If at the time when a vehicle is left in the parking place there is no ticket machine at that parking place or all the ticket machines at that parking place carry notices upon them by a person duly authorised by the Council indicating that they are not in use or out of order the driver of that vehicle shall pay the parking fee for use of that parking place on demand by any duly authorised officer or servant of the Council for which he shall receive a ticket or tickets. Article 12.0, 15.0 and 19.0 shall apply to any such ticket or tickets as though they were a ticket or tickets purchased in accordance with Article 9.0

12.0 DISPLAY OF TICKET

12.1 Any ticket or tickets issued including a season ticket or parking permit shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued in the following manner

- (a) in the case of an authorised vehicle which is fitted with a transparent windscreen by sticking the ticket or tickets to the inside surface of the windscreen so that it is facing forwards and can be clearly seen from the front of the vehicle
- (b) in the case of an authorised vehicle which is not fitted with a transparent windscreen by sticking the ticket or tickets on the nearside of the authorised vehicle not more than 2 metres and not less than 0.75 metres above the surface of the parking place in the immediate vicinity of the authorised vehicle so that it is facing forwards and the day and time of issue and other printed matter shown on the front of the ticket can be clearly seen from the outside of the vehicle

13.0 NON-TRANSFER OF TICKETS

13.1 It shall be an offence for the driver of a vehicle using the parking place in Column (1) of Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule to display any ticket other than the current ticket or tickets issued and each ticket purchased shall be valid on date of purchase only (except Mundeford Quay and Mayors Mead where tickets are purchased for more than twenty four hours)

13.2 Each parking ticket shall be valid only for the vehicle for which it was purchased and shall not be valid if the ticket is transferred to another vehicle and in the event that the vehicle is parked in another parking place or places on the same date as that shown on the parking ticket then the parking ticket shall not be valid in that parking place or places

14.0 DAMAGED OR FOREIGN COINS

No person shall insert in any ticket machine in the parking place any bent or damaged or foreign coins by way of payment of the charge in respect of a vehicle

15.0 LIABILITY TO AND AMOUNT OF PENALTY CHARGE

15.1 Subject to Article 18.2 the Owner of a vehicle shall be liable to pay an additional amount of Sixty Pounds (£60) (“the penalty charge”) in the following circumstances

- (a) if an authorised vehicle is left in the parking place for longer than the period for which payment was made
- (b) if an authorised vehicle is left in the parking place and no charge is paid
- (c) if a vehicle other than an authorised vehicle is left in the parking place
- (d) if an authorised vehicle is left in a parking place specified in Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule and in respect of which a valid season ticket or parking permit in accordance with Part II of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule has not been issued
- (e) if an authorised vehicle is left in any position other than that specified in Column (2) of Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule or is causing an obstruction
- (f) if an authorised vehicle is left in a parking place and the ticket issued is not displayed in accordance with Article 12.0
- (g) if a vehicle which does not fall within the categories specified in Article 31.4(d) is parked in an area reserved for disabled drivers in accordance with Article 31.4(d)
- (h) if a vehicle is left in a parking place contrary to the requirements of Article 24.0
- (i) where there is a contravention of Articles 6.0, 8.0, 9.0, 13.0, 21.0, 22.0, 23.0, 25.0, 27.0, 29.0, 30.0 and 31.0

15.2 Where a vehicle has incurred a penalty charge a Parking Attendant shall attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a penalty charge notice (“the penalty charge notice”) which shall include the following particulars

- (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence the number of trade plate carried by the vehicle
- (b) the time at which the Parking Attendant observed that the penalty charge had been incurred
- (c) the grounds on which the Parking Attendant believes that a penalty charge is payable with respect to the vehicle
- (d) a statement that the penalty charge of Sixty Pounds (£60) is required to be paid
- (e) that the penalty charge must be paid before the end of the period of 28 days beginning with the date of the penalty charge notice
- (f) that if the penalty charge is paid before the end of the period of 14 days beginning with the date of the penalty charge notice, the amount of the penalty charge will be reduced to Thirty Pounds (£30)
- (g) that if the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the 28 day period, a notice to owner may be served by the Council on the person appearing to them to be the owner of the vehicle
- (h) the address to which payment of the penalty charge must be sent

16.0 MAXIMUM PERIOD FOR WHICH AN AUTHORISED VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT AFTER PENALTY CHARGE INCURRED

16.1 The period for which an authorised vehicle may be left in the parking place after the penalty charge has been incurred shall not exceed twelve hours and the driver of the vehicle shall not leave it in the parking place for longer than that

16.2 If an authorised vehicle is left in the parking place for more than the said period after the penalty charge has been incurred it shall be the duty of a Parking Attendant to attach to the authorised vehicle in a conspicuous position a further penalty charge notice which shall include the particulars mentioned in Article 15.2 and the following additional particulars namely the time at which he or she first noticed that the authorised vehicle had been left in the parking place for more than the prescribed period after the penalty charge had been incurred

17.0 RESTRICTIONS ON REMOVAL OF TICKETS AND PENALTY CHARGE NOTICES

17.1 When the ticket or tickets have been displayed on an authorised vehicle in accordance with Article 12.0 above no person shall remove the ticket or tickets from the authorised vehicle until the authorised vehicle is removed from the parking place

17.2 Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to an authorised vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Articles 15.2 or 16.2 no person not being the driver of the authorised vehicle or person duly authorised by the Council shall remove the penalty charge notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver

18.0 MANNER OF PAYMENT OF PENALTY CHARGE

18.1 The excess charge of Sixty Pounds (£60) shall be paid to the Council either by cheque banker's draft money order or postal order which shall be delivered or sent by post or by cash in person to the Council's Resources Department situate at the Civic Offices Bridge Street Christchurch Dorset BH23 1AZ. Provided that if the Twenty-Eight day period expires upon a day on which the said Department is closed the period within which payment of the penalty charge shall be paid to the Council shall be extended until 1pm on the next full day on which the said Department is open

18.2 Provided that if within fourteen days following the date on which the penalty charge notice is issued and the driver tenders to the Council's Resources Department aforesaid the sum of Thirty Pounds (£30) then such sum or sums may be accepted by the Council in satisfaction of the penalty charge

19.0 INDICATIONS BY TICKET MACHINES AND TICKETS AS EVIDENCE

Unless the contrary is proved:-

19.1 If at any time an authorised vehicle is left in a parking place without any parking ticket displayed indicating payment of the appropriate charge in accordance with Article 11.0 it shall be presumed that no parking charge has been paid in respect of that vehicle

19.2 If at any time while an authorised vehicle is left in the parking place there is displayed on the authorised vehicle a ticket or tickets issued by a ticket machine indicating the day and the time of issue of the ticket or tickets and the time indicated on the ticket machine clock shows that the period for which the ticket or tickets are valid has expired it shall be presumed that the charge specified in Article 9.0 has been duly paid for the authorised vehicle and that the period for which the payment was made by the charge has already expired

19.3 If at any time there is waiting in a parking place a vehicle whereon there is displayed one or more parking tickets but such ticket or tickets represent payment of a charge less than the charge prescribed in the Fifty-Eighth Schedule in respect of the parking place for the class to which the said vehicle belongs it shall be presumed that no parking charge has been paid in respect of the vehicle so waiting

- 19.4 If at any time there is waiting in a parking place a vehicle whereon there is displayed one or more parking tickets purchased from a parking place other than the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting it shall be presumed that no parking charge has been paid in respect of that vehicle
- 19.5 Without prejudice to Article 13.2 if at any time there is waiting in a parking place a vehicle whereon there is displayed one or more parking tickets or a parking permit purchased for display on a vehicle other than the vehicle so waiting it shall be presumed that no parking charge has been paid in respect of that vehicle
- 19.6 If at any time while an authorised vehicle is left in the parking place there is displayed on the authorised vehicle a ticket or tickets issued by a ticket machine indicating the day and the time of issue of the ticket or tickets and the time indicated on the ticket machine clock shows that the period for which the ticket or tickets are valid has expired more than twenty four hours later than the time on the ticket those indications shall
- (a) be evidence that the vehicle was left in the parking place for longer after the penalty charge had been incurred than the time authorised by Article 16.1
 - (b) be evidence that the charge was incurred for longer after the penalty charge had been incurred than the time authorised by Article 16.1

20.0 EXEMPTION FROM CHARGES

Except where expressly provided therein Articles 9.0 to 19.0 shall not apply to:-

- 20.1 pedal cycles and
- 20.2 solo motor cycles left in parking places provided they are parked so as not to occupy a parking bay or obstruct a parking bay or a pedestrian or vehicular access aisle

20.3 any vehicle being a vehicle for disabled persons and which is exempt from vehicle excise duty by virtue of paragraphs (18) or (19) of Schedule 2 to the Vehicles Excise and Registration Act 1994

21.0 SPEED OF VEHICLES

No person shall in the parking place drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle at a speed which exceeds ten miles per hour or such lesser speed as shall be reasonable according to the circumstances of the case at the time

22.0 RESTRICTION OF CLASS OF VEHICLE USING PARKING PLACE AND ON MANNER OF PARKING

Subject to Article 20.0 no vehicle other than a vehicle specified in Column (3) of Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule shall be left in the parking place and no vehicle shall be left in a position other than that specified in Column (2) of Part I of the Fifty-Eighth Schedule

23.0 DRIVERS TO SWITCH OFF ENGINE OF VEHICLE

The driver of a vehicle using the parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking bay and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from a parking place

24.0 VEHICLES IN PARKING PLACE TO BE IN SATISFACTORY CONDITION

The driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in the parking place if the vehicle is in such condition as to be likely to cause a danger to other users of the parking place or damage to the surface condition of the parking place

25.0 DRIVER NOT TO SOUND THE HORN OF VEHICLE IN PARKING PLACE

The driver of a vehicle using the parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument in or attached to the vehicle except that the driver may sound the horn in or attached to the vehicle for the purpose of giving any necessary warning when the vehicle is in motion

26.0 VEHICLE IN PARKING PLACE NOT TO BE DRIVEN EXCEPT FOR ENTERING OR LEAVING

No person shall except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council drive a vehicle in the parking place except in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of entering and departing from the parking place and driving a vehicle around the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order for the purpose of locating an available parking bay

27.0 PROHIBITION OF LOUD SPEAKERS ETC

No person shall in the parking place operate any wireless loud speaker or similar device in or fixed or connected to a vehicle wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise likely to cause disturbance or annoyance to the users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood

28.0 PROHIBITION OF BREACHES OF THE PEACE

No person shall in the parking place use any obscene threatening abusive or insulting language gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned

29.0 RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF A VEHICLE IN THE PARKING PLACE

No person shall use any part of the parking place or a vehicle left in the parking place

29.1 for camping purposes or overnight sleeping

29.2 for cooking or sanitary purposes

29.3 for the purpose of carrying out any work of washing maintenance or repair to a vehicle parked thereon except such as may be reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from the parking place or

29.4 in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of any goods or of the skill or services of any persons unless authorised by the Council in writing

30.0 PROHIBITION OF PASSAGE THROUGH CAR PARK

No person shall use the parking place as a means of through passage for vehicles proceeding from one road to another or to a further length of the said road

31.0 DIRECTIONS FOR TRAFFIC TO BE FOLLOWED

When in the parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of

31.1 Indicating the entrance to or the exit from the parking place or

31.2 Indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place

31.3 Indicating an area reserved for season ticket or permit holders

31.4 Indicating an area reserved for disabled drivers

no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle

- (a) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated
- (b) in a direction other than that specified
- (c) so that it enters the area reserved for season ticket or parking permit holders unless it is an authorised vehicle in respect of which a season ticket or parking permit has been issued and a season ticket or parking permit is displayed in accordance with Article 12.0 as the case may be or
- (d) so that it enters the area reserved for disabled drivers unless the vehicle is either
 - (i) an invalid carriage or
 - (ii) an authorised vehicle left by the driver thereof who is a person to whom there has been issued a Disabled Persons Badge provided such a badge is displayed on the vehicle in a position as required by the Regulations as aforesaid

32.0 RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF THE PARKING PLACE

Without prejudice to the other provisions of this Order when in a parking place no person shall

- 32.1 Erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent booth stand building skip stall or other structure for any purpose whatsoever or deposit materials or excavate any surfaces without the prior written consent of the Council
- 32.2 Light or cause or permit to be lit any fire or barbecue
- 32.3 Carry out any trade or business activity or charitable activity without the prior written consent of the Council
- 32.4 Affix or attach posters bills or any advertising material whatsoever to either the walls or structure of the parking place or to any vehicle parked in the parking place or distribute leaflet or advertising material of any kind

- 32.5 Ride or use a skateboard roller skates or boots or similar thing or things
- 32.6 Play or participate in any formal or organised game sport or recreation in a parking place without the prior written consent of the Council
- 32.7 Use the parking place for the purpose of campaigning for political or other purposes
- 32.8 Damage or deface any furniture sign surface or structure or vehicle by means of graffiti or other action
- 32.9 Hold or take part in any organised picnic without the prior written consent of the Council
- 32.10 Carry out or permit to be carried out to the vehicle any work of cleaning construction alteration or maintenance or repair except such repair as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from the parking place
- 32.11 Cause or permit a vehicle to be parked in such a manner in a parking place as to cause or be likely to cause an obstruction to other users of the parking place
- 32.12 Wantonly shout make any loud noise or otherwise cause a disturbance or annoyance to users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood
- 32.13 Park or cause to be left a caravan
- 32.14 Cause or permit to be thrown down dropped or otherwise deposited and left any waste litter or detritus

33.0 APPLICATION OF ENACTMENT

Sub-Sections (4) (5) and (6) of Section 47 of the Act shall apply to the parking places as if it was a parking place provided on the highway

34.0 REMOVAL ETC OF VEHICLES FROM A PARKING PLACE

- 34.1 When a Parking Attendant is of the opinion that any of the provisions of Articles 6.0, 8.0, 9.0, 12.0, 13.0, 16.0, 22.0, 24.0, 32.10, 32.11, and 32.13 have been contravened in respect of any vehicle or caravan left in the parking place he may remove the said vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from the said parking place
- 34.2 When an authorised vehicle is waiting in the parking place in contravention of Article 22.0 any person duly authorised by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply therewith
- 34.3 A Parking Attendant may move or cause to be moved in case of emergency to any place he or she thinks fit any vehicle left in the parking place

35.0 MANNER OF REMOVAL OF VEHICLES

Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 34.0 may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he or she may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he or she may think necessary to enable him or her to remove it or alter its position as the case may be

36.0 SAFE CUSTODY OF VEHICLES REMOVED FROM THE PARKING PLACE

When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from the parking place by virtue of Article 34.0 he or she shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle following such removal Section 101 and 102 of the Act shall be applicable by the Council in respect of the vehicle insofar as the Council shall desire
