#### City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (Moving Traffic) (Consolidation) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2010

# PRINCE'S WAY THORNTON ROAD LITTLE HORTON LANE AND GODWIN STREET BRADFORD

The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984" and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 "the Act of 2004" and with those persons and organisations specified in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:

1. In this Order, the expression "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (Moving Traffic) (Consolidation) Order 2009 hereinafter referred to as "the Consolidation Order" shall have effect as though:

(a) There were substituted:

- (i) In Schedule 1 the items numbered 118 and 175 set out in Schedule 1A to this Order; and
- (ii) In Schedule 9 the item numbered 32 set out in Schedule 9A to this Order.

(b) There were added to that Order:

- (i) In Schedule 5 the item numbered 55 set out in Schedule 5A to this Order;
- (ii) In Schedule 8 the items numbered 63 and 64 set out in Schedule 8A to this Order;
- (iii) In Schedule 9 the items numbered 66, 67 and 68 set out in Schedule 9A to this Order;
- (iv) In Schedule 10 the items numbered 66, 67, 68 and 69 set out in Schedule 10A to this Order;
- (v) In Schedule 20 the item numbered 23 set out in Schedule 20A to this Order;
- (vi) In Schedule 25 the items numbered 2 and 3 set out in Schedule 25A to this Order.

- (c) There were revoked from that Order:
  - (i) In Schedule 2 the item numbered 24;
  - (ii) In Schedule 3 the items numbered 5, 43, 44 and 52;
  - (iii) In Schedule 5 the items numbered 17, 36, 37 and 40;
  - (iv) In Schedule 13 the item numbered 25.
- (d) The following definition was added to Article1 of Part I to the Consolidation Order:

"custody vehicle" means a motor vehicle being uses in the service of Her Majesty's Courts Service and is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of persons in custody.

- 3. Designation of Restrictions and application of the Consolidation Order
  - (a) The provisions of the Consolidation Order shall apply to any area designated as a prohibited movement, mandatory movement, prohibition of vehicles, bus priority measure, pedal cycle measure or pedestrian zone by this Order, as if in those provisions any reference to a prohibited movement, mandatory movement, prohibition of vehicles, bus priority measure, pedal cycle measure or pedestrian zone included a reference to an area designated as a prohibited movement, mandatory movement, prohibition of vehicles, bus priority measure, pedal cycle measure or pedestrian zone by this Order and as if any reference to a Schedule to the Consolidation Order included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
  - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
  - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

5. This Order is made on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June 2010 and shall come into force on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 2010 and may be cited as the "City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (Moving Traffic) (Consolidation) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2010".
