

THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (BRENTWOOD BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT NO.1) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Chelmsford City Council acting on behalf of the South Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an agreement dated 31 March 2011 (and subsequently varied by Deed of Variation on 15 June 2011 and 27 July 2012) has made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the Order:

All measurements are taken as accurately as possible and are taken from the extended kerb line unless stated otherwise.

1. To revoke 'No Waiting at Any Time' on the following lengths of roads in the Borough of Brentwood:

Woodman Road, WarleySouth side – From a point 5 metres northeast of its junction with Th south-westerly direction to a point 5 metres southwest of its junction Chase.		
Shenfield Green, Shenfield	 Both sides – From its south-western junction with Hutton Road south-eastwards for 15 metres. Both sides - From its north-eastern junction with Hutton Road south-eastwards for 15 metres.
