



THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (BRENTWOOD BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 22) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Chelmsford City Council acting on behalf of the South Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 30 June 2022 has made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

Effect of the Order:

All measurements are taken as accurately as possible and are taken from the extended kerb line unless stated otherwise.

1. To revoke all parking restrictions on the following lengths of road in the Borough of Brentwood:

Primrose Hill, Brentwood	Both sides – from its junction with Kings Road north-eastwards to a point 32 metres southwest of its junction with Crown Street. Map tiles TQ590 932 & TQ590 935

2. To introduce ‘Resident Permit Parking 8am-11pm Zone B’ on the following lengths of road in the Borough of Brentwood:

Primrose Hill, Brentwood	<p>Northwest side –from a point 30 metres northeast of its junction with Kings Road north-eastwards for 21 metres.</p> <p>Northwest side – from a point 96 metres northeast of its junction with Kings Road north-eastwards for 10 metres.</p> <p>Northwest side – from a point 32 metres southwest of its junction with Crown Street south-westwards for 39 metres. 3. To introduce ‘No Waiting at Any Time’ on the following lengths of road in the Borough of Brentwood:

Primrose Hill, Brentwood	<p>Northwest side – from its junction with Kings Road north-eastwards for 30 metres.</p> <p>Northwest side – from a point 51 metres northeast of its junction with Kings Road north-eastwards for 45 metres.</p> <p>Northwest side – from a point 106 metres northeast of its junction with Kings Road north-eastwards for 40 metres.</p> <p>Southeast side – from its junction with Kings Road north-eastwards to a point 32 metres southwest of its junction with Crown Street. 4. To revoke ‘No Waiting Monday to Friday 2pm-3pm’ on the following lengths of road in the Borough of Brentwood:

Station Lane, Ingatestone	<p>Northeast side – from a point 11 metres southeast of the entrance to Ingatestone station car park north-westwards for a distance of 61 metres.</p> <p>Northeast side – from a point 30 meters southeast of its junction with The Paddocks north-westwards to a point 10 metres northwest of its junction with The Paddocks.</p> <p>Southwest side - from a point 10 metres southeast of its junction with Gatehouse Mews north-westwards to a point 25 metres southeast of its junction with High Street/Roman Road. The Paddocks, Ingatestone	Both sides – from its junction with Station Lane north-eastwards for 15 metres. Map tile TQ645 990
Gatehouse Mews, Ingatestone	Both sides – from its junction with Station Lane in a south-westwards and then north-westwards direction for its entire length, including the turning head. Map tile TQ645 990

5. To introduce ‘No Waiting at Any Time’ on the following lengths of road in the Borough of Brentwood:

Station Lane, Ingatestone	Northeast side – from the northwest side of the level crossing north-westwards to a point 45 metres northwest of the entrance to Ingatestone car park. Northeast side – from a point 30 meters southeast of its junction with The Paddocks north-westwards to a point 10 metres northwest of its junction with The Paddocks. Southwest side - from the northwest side of the level crossing north-westwards to a point 25 metres southeast of its junction with High Street/Roman Road. Map tile TQ645 990
The Paddocks, Ingatestone	Both sides – from its junction with Station Lane north-eastwards for 15 metres. Map tile TQ645 990
Gatehouse Mews, Ingatestone	Both sides – from its junction with Station Lane in a south-westwards and then north-westwards direction for its entire length, including the turning head. Map tile TQ645 990

6. To revoke 'No Waiting Mon to Fri 10am-11am & 2pm-3pm' on the following lengths of road in the Borough of Brentwood:

Whadden Chase, Ingatestone	Southwest side – from a point 15 metres northwest of its junction with Roman Road north-westwards for 26 metres. Northeast side – from a point 10 metres southeast of its junction with Wakelin Chase north-westwards for 26 metres. Map tile TQ640 990
The Quorn, Ingatestone	Both sides – from its junction with Whadden Chase south-westwards for 18 metres. Map tile TQ640 990
Wakelin Chase, Ingatestone	Both sides – from its junction with Whadden Chase north-eastwards for 13 metres. Map tile TQ640 990

7. To introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' on the following lengths of road in the Borough of Brentwood:

Whadden Chase, Ingatestone	Southwest side – from a point 15 metres northwest of its junction with Roman Road north-westwards for 26 metres. Northeast side – from a point 10 metres southeast of its junction with Wakelin Chase north-westwards for 26 metres. Map tile TQ640 990
The Quorn, Ingatestone	Both sides – from its junction with Whadden Chase south-westwards for 51 metres. Both sides – from its termination north-eastwards for 25 metres, including the turning head. Map tiles TQ640 987 & TQ640 990
Wakelin Chase, Ingatestone	Both sides – from its junction with Whadden Chase north-eastwards for 13 metres. Map tile TQ640 990
Fryerning Lane, Ingatestone	South side – from a point 10 metres northwest of its junction with Bakers Lane north-westwards for 5 metres. Map tile TQ645 995
Roman Road, Mountnessing	Southeast side – from a point 15 metres northeast of its junction with Roman Close south-westwards for 30 metres. Map tiles TQ625 975 & TQ630 975
Roman Close, Mountnessing	Both sides – from its junction with Roman Road south-eastwards for 19 metres. Map tiles TQ625 975 & TQ630 975
Westbourne Drive, Brentwood	Both sides – from a point 10 metres southwest of its south-western junction with Shevon Way north-eastwards for 26 metres. Both sides – from a point 10 metres southwest of its junction with Lilley Close north-eastwards for 25 metres. Both sides – from its north-eastern junction with Shevon Way south-westwards for 10 metres. Map tile TQ575 927
Shevon Way, Brentwood	Both sides – from the south-western junction with Westbourne Drive south-eastwards for 10 metres. Northeast side – from the property boundary of Nos.8 & 10 Shevon Way south-eastwards and then eastwards for 26 metres. Both sides – from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Lindsey Close northwards and north-westwards for 26 metres. Both sides – from a point 10 metres southeast of the north-eastern junction with Westbourne Drive north-westwards to a point 10 metres northwest of the north-eastern junction with Westbourne Drive.

Lilley Close, Brentwood	Both sides – from its junction with Westbourne Drive north-westwards for 10 metres. Map tile TQ575 927

8. To revoke 'Pay & Display Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Max Stay 2 Hours' and replace with 'Pay & Display Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Max Stay 2 Hours, No Return within 2 Hours' on the following lengths of road in the Borough of Brentwood:

Application to the High Court: Anyone who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Chelmsford City Council acting on behalf of the South Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 30 June 2022 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") hereby makes the following Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1) 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers.

1. The Amendment Order shall come into operation on the 19th day of February 2024 and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Brentwood Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-street parking places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.22) Order 2024.
