

THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (BRENTWOOD BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT NO.4) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Chelmsford City Council acting on behalf of the South Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an agreement dated 31 March 2011 (and subsequently varied by Deed of Variation on 15 June 2011 and 27 July 2012) proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the Order:

All measurements are taken as accurately as possible and are taken from the extended kerb line unless stated otherwise.

Date of operation: This Order will come into operation on 30 November 2020.
