**Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2015
Amendment Order No.6 2017**

Brighton & Hove City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 19, 32, 35, 35A, 44, 45, 46, 46A, 47, 49, 51, 53, 55, 61, 63, 63A, 66, 117 and 124 (1) (c) & (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as amended and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as The Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2015 Amendment Order No.6 2017 and shall come into operation on the 24th day of July 2017.
2. The Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2015 is amended as follows:

Delete the following:

8	Freshfield Road	East	From the common boundary of Nos.188 & 190 Freshfield Road, southwards to a point 6 metres north of the northern kerbline of Evelyn Terrace	U

Replace with the following:

Item No.	Street Name	Side of Road	Description	Zone
8	Freshfield Road	East	From the common boundary of Nos.188 & 190 Freshfield Road, southwards to a point 25 metres north of the northern kerbline of Cuthbert Road.	U


Add new item:

Item No.	Street Name	Side of Road	Description	Zone
8a	Freshfield Road	East	From a point 6 metres south of the southern kerbline of Cuthbert Road southwards to the southern boundary wall of No.124 Freshfield Road.	U
8b	Freshfield Road	East	From a point 6 metres north of the northern kerbline of Evelyn Terrace northwards for a distance of 6 metres	U
