ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL

Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting on Verges and Footways) (Pool Valley) Experimental Order 2020

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting on Verges and Footways) (Pool Valley) Experimental Order 2020 and shall come into operation on the 2nd day of October 2020.
- 2. The Council's Executive Director Economy, Environment & Culture or any person authorised by him is authorised to modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any of it in accordance with the provisions of section 10(2) of the Act.
- 3. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated or reenacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on movement by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
- 5. The Brighton & Hove (Various Roads) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting on Verges and Footways Order) 2013 is amended as follows:-

Schedule 1 - Prohibition of Parking on Verge and Footway

Renumber existing item 5b to 5d and insert new items:

Item No.	Road	Side	Description
5b	Old Steine	South Side (Southern- most carriageway)	The section between the southern carriageway for westbound traffic southwards adjacent to Royal York Buildings and 39-40 Old Steine to its southern boundary.
5c	Pool Valley	Both Sides	Whole Length
