Brighton & Hove (Zone M) Experimental Order 2020 Amendment No.1 2021

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall be cited as the "Brighton and Hove (Zone M) Experimental Order 2020 Amendment No.1 2021".
- 2. The provisions of this Order will come into operation on the 24th day of March 2021.
- 3. The Council's Executive Director Economy, Environment & Culture or any person authorised by him is authorised to modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any of it in accordance with the provisions of section 10(2) of the Act.
- 4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated or reenacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 5. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on movement by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
- 6. The Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 is amended as follows:-

Part 12.1 - Loading Bays At Any Time
