**BRIGHTON & HOVE VARIOUS CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES CONSOLIDATION
ORDER 2018 AMENDMENT ORDER No.9 2022**

Brighton & Hove City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 4, 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 (1) (c) & (d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as amended and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as The Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.9 2022 and shall come into operation on the 19th day of March 2022.
2. The Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 is amended as follows:



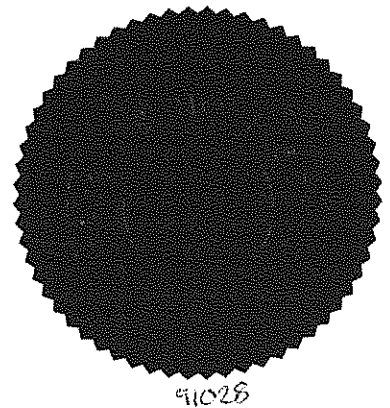
