Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.9 2023 (ref:TRO-38b-2023)

Brighton & Hove City Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4, 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 (1) (c) & (d) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as amended and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.9 2023 and shall come into operation on the 6th day of November 2023.
2. The Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 is amended as follows:

ARTICLE AMENDMENTS

PART 1 – GENERAL

After "Pedal Cycle" add the following definition:

- "Pedal Cycle Hangar Scheme" means the pedal cycle hangar scheme operated on behalf of Brighton & Hove City Council;

After "Pedal Cycle Parking Place" add the following definition:

- "Pedal Cycle Parking Place – Bike Hangar" means a length of carriageway designated by this Order as a place for Pedal Cycles to be stored as part of the Pedal Cycle Hangar Scheme

PART 3 – PARKING PLACES

Pedal Cycle Parking Places

After paragraph 4 add in new paragraph as follows:

(5) Schedule 1 Part 15.3 is for the parking of Pedal Cycles used for the purpose of the Pedal Cycle Hangar Scheme only.

PART 10 – INDEX OF SCHEDULE 1

Part 15 – Pedal Cycle Parking

After existing Part 15.2 add new part as follows:

Part 15.3 Pedal Cycle Parking Place- Bike Hangar

SCHEDULE 1 AMENDMENTS:

Part 15.3 Pedal Cycle Parking Place – Bike Hangar

Add the following new items:

1	Hollingdean Street	North	From a point 14.3 metres west of the western kerbline of Roedale Road westwards for 5 metres
