

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**Brighton & Hove (Red Routes) (A23) Experimental Order 2024 Amendment
No.2 2024 (ref: TRO-5b-2024)**

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1), 4, 9, 10, 45,46, 49, 53, 124 (1) (c) & (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Brighton & Hove (Red Routes) (A23) Experimental Order 2024 Amendment No.2 2024 and shall come into operation on the 6th day of July 2024.
2. The Council’s Corporate Director City Services or any person authorised by her is authorised to modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any of it in accordance with the provisions of section 10(2) of the Act.
3. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on movement by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
4. The Brighton & Hove (Red Routes) (A23) Experimental Order 2024 is amended as follows:

The Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2024 Schedule 1 is amended as follows:

Zone Y

Part 12.1 Loading bays at any time

Add in the following item:

Item No.	Street Name	Side of Road	Description
3a	London Road	East	(3 metres wide) From a point 42 metres north of the northern kerbline of Baker Street northwards for 22.1 metres

Part 12.3 Loading Bays Monday to Sunday – 30 minutes (No return within 2 hours)
