

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL**

**Brighton & Hove (Bus Lanes) Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.1 2025
(TRO-30d-2024)**

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2), 4(1) and (2), 124(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act (“the Act”) as amended and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the above-named Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Brighton & Hove (Bus Lanes) Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.1 2025 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of September 2025.

2. The Brighton & Hove (Bus Lanes) Consolidation Order 2018 is amended as follows:

SCHEDULE 1 AMENDMENTS:

Part 1.1 Bus Lanes At Any Time

Delete the following items:

32	Pavilion Parade	From a point 8.5 metres north of the northern kerbline Pavilion Street southwards to Old Steine (total distance 117 metres see also item 28)	Northbound	Buses, Taxis and Private Hire Vehicles


