**BRIGHTON & HOVE SEAFRONT (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS)  
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2008 AMENDMENT ORDER No.1 2013**

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 19, 32, 35, 35A, 43, 44, 45, 46, 46A, 47, 49, 51, 53, 55, 61, 63, 63A, 66, 117 and 124 (1) (c) & (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as amended and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the above named Order.

The provisions of this Order will come into operation on the *1<sup>st</sup>* day of *March* 2013 and amend the Brighton & Hove Seafront (Various Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2008, as amended, as follows:-

**ARTICLE AMENDMENTS:**

**PART 10 – INDEX OF SCHEDULE 1**

**Part 1 No Waiting Restrictions**

After existing Part 1.3 add new Part to the Index as follows:

**SCHEDULE 1 AMENDMENTS:**

**Part 1.1 No Waiting At Any Time**

Amend item 4 King's Road: delete "and Waterloo Street" and substitute "and the eastern boundary wall of No.1 Brunswick Terrace"

Amend item 12 Marine Parade: delete the existing description and substitute "From its junction with the Old Steine and Madeira Drive to the eastern kerbline of Burlington Street (excluding the length of road on the northern side from the eastern kerbline of Atlingworth Street to the western kerbline of Charlotte Street)"

After existing Part 1.3 insert new Part in the Schedule as follows:

**Part 1.4 No Waiting Monday to Saturday 9am to 6pm**

Item No.	Street Name	Side of Road	Description
1	King's Road	North	From the western kerbline of Western Street westwards for a distance of 17 metres
