Brighton & Hove (Bolsover Road) (One-Way) Order 2015

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as amended and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the above named Order.

- This Order may be cited as the Brighton & Hove (Bolsover Road) (One-Way) Order 2015 and comes into operation on the 2^M day of March 2015.
- 2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle (not including pedal cycles) to proceed in those lengths of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order other than in the direction specified in the adjoining section of column 3 of that Schedule except in the case of a vehicle in the course of an emergency for fire service, ambulance service or police purposes or a vehicle in the service of a local authority in the course of road cleansing or gully emptying.
