

CITY COUNCIL OF BRISTOL

(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (PAY AND DISPLAY) ORDER 2000

The City Council of Bristol (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33 and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Act 1991, as amended (whether generally or in relation to the Council's area or parts thereof) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1991") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order: -

PART I

GENERAL

Commencement And Citation

1. This order shall come into operation on the 1st April 2000 and maybe cited as the City Council of Bristol (Off- Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) Order 2000.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"charging hours" means the period of a day during which a charge is made for a vehicle waiting at the parking places specified in Schedule 1 to this order;


"Council" means the City Council of Bristol;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as it has in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 as amended by the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991 and the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1992;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as it has in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986 as amended by the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1991;

"discounted penalty charge" means a charge:

- (a) of the amount specified in relation to discounted penalty charges in column 2 of Schedule 3 to this order;
- (b) incurred pursuant to Article 17(1), (2) and (3) of this order in consequence of a contravention of the provisions of this order; and



(c) payable in accordance with the provisions of Article 20 of this order (that is to say where a penalty charge has become payable pursuant to Article 17 of this order and payment is received within 14 days of the issue of the penalty charge notice);

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person in charge of the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place and, where a separate person acts as steersman of a vehicle, includes that person as well as any other person in charge of the vehicle, and "drive" shall be construed accordingly;

"enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"goods" includes postal packets of any description; and

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description (whether in the course of trade or not) or a trailer so adapted;

"immobilisation device" means any device or appliance designed or adapted to be fixed to a vehicle for the purpose of preventing it from being driven or otherwise put into motion, being a device or appliance of a type approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions for use for that purpose;

"immobilisation exempt vehicle" means:

- (a) a disabled person's vehicle or an invalid carriage;
- (b) a vehicle which displays a local exemption parking permit which has been issued by the Council to a doctor, district nurse, midwife or other medically or otherwise professionally qualified person for use when engaged in emergency duties, and is subject to conditions or limitations impose upon its use by the Council; or
- (c) a diplomatic registered vehicle in the execution of official duties;

"invalid carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"light goods vehicle" means a goods vehicle which has an operating weight not exceeding 3.5 tonnes;

"motor cycle" has the same meaning as it has in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as it has in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"notice to owner" means a notice served pursuant to paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 6 to the Act of 1991 and complying with paragraph 1(2) of the said Schedule;

"owner" in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept;

"parking attendant" means a person duly authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any parking place specified in this order in accordance with provisions contained in section 63A of the Act of 1984;

"parking bay" means a part of a parking place marked out for the leaving of a vehicle;

"parking place" means an area of land authorised by this order to be used as a parking place;

"passenger carrying vehicle" means a vehicle constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects;

"penalty charge" means a charge:

- (a) of the amount specified in relation to penalty charges in column 2 of Schedule 3 to this order;
- (b) incurred pursuant to Article 17(1), (2) and (3) of this order in consequence of a contravention of the provisions of this order; and
- (c) payable in accordance with provisions of Article 19 of this order (but subject to the provisions of Article 20 of this order);

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued or served by a parking attendant pursuant to the provisions of section 66 of the Road Traffic Act 1991;

"prepaid ticket" means a ticket issued by the Council for which payment has already been made to the Council;

"prescribed" means prescribed by any enactment or any regulation, order, direction or other instrument made thereunder;

"relevant position" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986 as amended by the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1991;

"special parking permit" means a permit issued by the Council authorising the permit holder to park their private motor car in one or more parking places free of any charge and subject to such conditions or limitations which may be imposed on the use of the permit; and

"vehicle" means any vehicle, whether or not it is in a fit state for use on the roads, and includes any chassis or body, with or without wheels, appearing to have formed part of such a vehicle, and any load carried by and anything attached to such a vehicle.

- (2) For the purpose of this order a vehicle towing a caravan or a trailer shall be deemed to be a goods vehicle in excess of 1525kg unladen weight.
- (3) For the purpose of this order any mechanically propelled passenger carrying vehicle constructed or adapted with seats for nine or more persons (inclusive of the driver) shall be deemed to be a goods vehicle in excess of 1525kg unladen weight.
- (4) References in this order to a ticket issuing machine shall be construed as references to the apparatus or device used as a means to issue tickets at a parking place and as a means to collect the charges payable in respect of a vehicle in the parking place and generally approved for the purpose by the Secretary of State for Environment, Transport and the Regions.
- (5) References in this order to a ticket or tickets shall be construed as references to a ticket or tickets purchased from a ticket issuing machine located within the parking place by the insertion therein of the appropriate coin or coins.
- (6) The amounts of the penalty charge and discounted penalty charge have been determined by the Council pursuant to section 74 of the Act of 1991 and with the approval of the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions in accordance with the requirements of the Act of 1991.
- (7) Any reference in this order to any enactment or regulations made thereunder shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment or regulations.

PART 2

AUTHORISATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES

Designation of parking places

3. Each of the areas of land specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this order, as a parking place for such vehicles or classes of vehicles as referred to in column 4 of the said Schedule and, on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that parking place in the said Schedule.

Power to suspend use of parking place or part of parking place

4. Nothing in this order shall prevent the Council, by notice displayed at the parking place -

- (a) from closing a parking place or any part thereof for any period;
- (b) from setting aside for special use or for use only by specially authorised vehicles of any part or parts of a parking place on all days or on certain days or during certain parts of certain days.

Use of parking places: general requirements

- 5. Where in Schedule 1 to this order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or on specified days or during specified hours the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place:-
 - (a) unless it is of a specified class;
 - (b) in any position except such position as may be indicated by white lines, barrier posts or other similar indication;
 - (c) in such a position as to obstruct access to the parking place or obstruct the access roads within the parking place or on any ramps or entrance ways leading to the parking place and forming part of it;
 - (d) on days or during hours other than those specified in Schedule 1 to this order, or for longer than the maximum period as specified in the said Schedule; or
 - (e) in a position marked for use by a disabled persons vehicle unless it is a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge.

Restriction of manner of standing, movement and conduct in parking place

- 6. The driver of a vehicle shall not, except with and subject to the terms of any permission in writing from the Council in the particular case, cause or permit it:-
 - (a) to wait in a parking place or any part thereof at any time when the parking place or that part (as the case may be) has been closed in accordance with the provisions of Article 4(a) of this order;
 - (b) to wait in any part of a parking place at a time when that part has been set aside for special use or for use by a specially authorised vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 4(b) of this order, unless the vehicle is so authorised; or
 - (c) to enter a parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leave it otherwise than by an exit, or proceed within the parking place otherwise than by the routes specified by notices or other indications displayed in or on the parking place.

- 7. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall not drive the vehicle -
 - (a) recklessly or at speed or in a manner which is dangerous to other users of that parking place, or without due care and attention or without reasonable consideration for other users of that parking place; or
 - (b) other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place.
- 8. The driver of a vehicle, or any other person, shall not, in a parking place -
 - (a) cause any nuisance, annoyance or inconvenience to the Council, its officers, servants or agents or to any other person whatsoever; or
 - (b) use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear, or so as to occasion a breach of the peace, or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.

Restriction of use of parking places

- 9. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in, or to depart from the parking place.
- 10. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place, or any other person shall not sound any horn or similar instrument -
 - (a) whilst the vehicle is stationary in a parking place, except when the driver is about to change the position of the vehicle in, or to depart from, that parking place, or
 - (b) (in any circumstances) between the hours of 11.30 p.m. and 7.00 a.m. on the following day.
- 11. Whilst a vehicle is in a parking place, the driver of a vehicle, or any other person -
 - (a) shall not carry out or permit to be carried out any work of maintenance or repair or the washing down of the vehicle except such maintenance or repair as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from that parking place;
 - (b) shall not place or permit to be placed on the vehicle, not being a motor cycle, any cover of the type normally used to protect the exterior of a vehicle from the weather during storage in the open air;

- (c) shall not use the vehicle or permit it to be used in connection with the sale of any vehicle or other article, or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of any skill or services; and
- (d) shall not use the vehicle or permit it to be used for residential or camping purposes.
- 12. The driver of a vehicle, whilst it is in a parking place, shall comply with any instructions given to him by a parking attendant as to the manner of waiting or the vehicle and shall remove the vehicle from the parking place on being required by a parking attendant so to do.

Payment for Parking

- 13. (1) Unless the vehicle is an invalid carriage or a disabled person's vehicle, or the vehicle displays a valid prepaid ticket, or the driver has been exempted by the Council from payment of the charge and (where the terms of the exemption so require) displays in the vehicle a special parking permit, the driver shall, in respect of the waiting of the vehicle in a parking place, pay the appropriate charge.
 - (2) The appropriate charge means the charge or charges specified in relation to that parking place in column 5 or column 6 of Schedule 1 to this order, and in relation to the days specified in column 3 of the said Schedule.
 - (3) The manner of payment shall be by the purchase of a ticket or tickets as soon as practicable upon entering the parking place.
 - (4) The purchase of a ticket or tickets shall entitle the driver to leave the vehicle in the parking place until the expiry of the period of validity indicated by the ticket or tickets so purchased, providing that the vehicle shall not wait in the parking place for a period of time greater than the maximum period of permitted waiting for that parking place.
 - (5) Any indication of fee paid or period of validity printed on a ticket purchased from a ticket issuing machine shall be conclusive evidence of the charge paid by the driver in respect of the waiting of a vehicle in a parking place; in the case of a ticket which indicates the period of validity only, the charge shall be that charge specified in column 5 of Schedule 1 to this order as appropriate to the period of validity indicated on the ticket.
 - (6) Any ticket which has not been purchased in accordance with the provisions of Article 13(3) of this order shall not be deemed a valid ticket in respect of the waiting of a vehicle in the parking place, except in the case of a ticket purchased by a driver conforming with the provisions of Article 32, Article 33, Article 34 or Article 35 of this order.

- 14. Upon obtaining a ticket or tickets, the driver of the vehicle shall exhibit the ticket or tickets on the vehicle -
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front glass windscreen extending across the vehicle to the near side, facing forwards in a position so as to be clearly visible to a parking attendant behind the near side of the glass of such windscreen behind; or
 - (b) in any other case, in a conspicuous position on or within the vehicle and so that the date and time shown on the ticket or tickets is clearly visible to a person standing at the near side of the vehicle.
- 15. When a ticket or tickets has or have been exhibited in or on a vehicle in accordance with Article 14 of this order no person, not being the driver or owner of the vehicle or a parking attendant, shall remove the ticket or tickets from the vehicle unless authorised by the said driver or owner, or a parking attendant so to do.
- 16. The holder of a prepaid ticket or a special parking permit shall comply with all relevant conditions or limitations imposed on the use of the said ticket or permit and shall display the ticket or permit in a conspicuous position on or within the vehicle so as to be clearly visible to a parking attendant whilst the vehicle is parked within the relevant parking places or places.

Contravention of order - Penalty Charge

- 17. (1) If a vehicle is left in a parking place on any day during the charging hours applicable to that parking place and no valid ticket, prepaid ticket or special parking permit is exhibited on the vehicle in the manner required by the provisions of this order then, unless the vehicle is an invalid carriage or a disabled person's vehicle, or the driver or owner of the vehicle has been exempted by the Council from payment of the charge, a penalty charge shall be payable by the owner of that vehicle.
 - (2) If a vehicle is left in a parking place on any day during the charging hours after the expiry of the period of validity of a ticket or tickets exhibited thereon and at a time when no other ticket or special parking permit valid for that time is so exhibited then, unless the vehicle is an invalid carriage or a disabled person's vehicle or the driver or owner of the vehicle has been exempted by the Council from payment of the charge, a penalty charge shall be payable by the owner of the vehicle.
 - (3) If a vehicle is left in a parking place on any day in contravention of or non-compliance with any other Article of this order a penalty charge shall be payable by the owner.
 - (4) Where a penalty charge under paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Article has been incurred the parking attendant may attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a penalty charge notice which shall include the following particulars -

- (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or, where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the general registration mark on the trade plate on the vehicle;
- (b) the time at which the parking attendant first noticed that a penalty charge had been incurred;
- (c) the grounds on which the parking attendant believes that a penalty charge is payable with respect to the vehicle;
- (d) a statement that the penalty charge is required to be paid to the Council within the period of 28 days beginning with the date of the penalty charge notice;
- (e) a statement that payment of the amount of the discounted penalty charge will be accepted in lieu of payment of the penalty charge if payment is made within 14 days (in accordance with the provisions of Article 20 of this order);
 - (f) a statement that if the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the 28 day period a notice to owner may be served by the Council;
 - (g) the address to which payment of the penalty charge is required to be sent and the manner to which it is required to be paid; and
 - (h) such other information as may be prescribed.

Restriction on Removal of Penalty Charge Notice

18. Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle under the provision of Article 17(4) of this order no person, not being the driver or owner of the vehicle, or a parking attendant, shall remove the penalty charge notice from the vehicle unless authorised by the said driver or owner, or a parking attendant, or duly authorised representative of the Council so to do.

Payment of Penalty Charge

19. Payment of the penalty charge, subject to the provisions of Article 20 of this order, shall (where payment is made other than by post) be made to the Council, by not later that 5.00 p.m. on the twenty-eighth day following the day on which the penalty charge was incurred, or where payment is sent by post, shall be sent as to reach the Council not later than the said twenty-eighth day.

Provided that if the said twenty-eighth day falls upon a Saturday or a day on which the payment facilities described below are closed, the period within which payment of the penalty charge shall be made to the Council shall be extended until 5.00 p.m. on the next full day on which the said facilities are open.

20. Where payment of the penalty charge is received by the Council within a period of fourteen days following the day on which the penalty charge was incurred the amount of the discounted penalty charge will be accepted in settlement of the penalty charge.

Provided that if the fourteenth day falls upon a Saturday or a day on which the Council facilities for receiving payment are closed, the period for payment of the discounted penalty charge shall be extended until 5.00 p.m. on the next full day on which the said facilities are open.

Immobilisation of Vehicle

- When a vehicle, other than an immobilisation exempt vehicle, is left in a parking place in contravention of the provisions contained in Article 5, Article 6, Article 13 and Article 14 of this order a person authorised on that behalf by the Council, or a parking attendant, may
 - (a) fix an immobilisation device to the vehicle while it remains in the position in which it is found, or
 - (b) remove or make arrangements for the removal of the vehicle, from the parking place to another place and fix an immobilisation device to it in that other place.

- 22. On any occasion when an immobilisation device is fixed to a vehicle in accordance with Article 21 of this order, the person fixing the device shall also affix to the vehicle a Notice
 - (a) indicating that such a device has been fixed to the vehicle and warning that no attempt should be made to drive it or otherwise put it in motion until it has been released from that device;
 - (b) specifying the steps to be taken in order to secure its release, and
 - (c) giving such other information as may be prescribed.
- 23. A vehicle to which an immobilisation device has been fixed in accordance with Article 21 of this order may only be released from that device by or under the direction of a person authorised in that behalf by the Council, or a parking attendant.
- 24. Subject to Article 23 of this order above, a vehicle to which an immobilisation device has been fixed in accordance with Article 21 of this order shall be released from that device on payment in any manner specified in that notice affixed to the vehicle under the provision of Article 22 of this order of such charge in respect of the release as the Council may from time to time determine.
- 25. When an immobilisation device has been fixed to a vehicle in accordance with Article 21 of this order no person, not being a person duly authorised by the Council, or a parking attendant, or under the direction of a person duly authorised by the Council, or a parking attendant, shall remove or attempt to remove the device from the vehicle.
- 26. Where a notice has been attached to a vehicle under the provision of Article 22 of this order no person, not being the driver or owner of the vehicle, or a duly authorised representative of the Council, or a parking attendant, shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised by the said driver or owner, or a duly authorised representative of the Council, or a parking attendant, so to do.

Removal of Vehicle

- 27. When a vehicle, other than an immobilisation exempt vehicle, is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in Article 5, Article 6, Article 13 or Article 14 of this order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council, or a parking attendant, may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place or, if it is left in contravention of paragraph (b) of Article 5 of this order, may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that paragraph.
- 28. Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 27 of this order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove the vehicle as aforesaid.

When a person authorised by the Council, or a parking attendant, removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from the parking place by virtue of Article 28 of this order he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.

Miscellaneous Provisions

- 30. Where, within the parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this order, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a disabled person's vehicle, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait unless it is a disabled persons' vehicle or displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position.
- Where within the parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this order, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a passenger carrying vehicle with seats for 9 to 16 persons (inclusive of driver) the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless it is such a passenger carrying vehicle.
- The provisions of this Article shall apply to the parking places described in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this order, as "Bristol First Church Lane", "Brunswick Square", "Meadow Street", "Philadelphia Court", "River Street" and "Stratton Street".
 - Between 0800 hours and 1800 hours on any day other than a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, any vehicle which has been removed from a parking bay in the parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this order shall not again be left in the same parking place until a period of two hours has elapsed since it was so removed.
- 33. The provisions of this Article shall apply to the parking places described in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this order as "Maritime Heritage Centre" and "Wapping Wharf".
 - Between 0800 hours and 2000 hours on any day other than a Saturday, Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, any vehicle which has been removed from a parking bay in the parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this order shall not again on the same day be left in the same parking place.
- The provisions of this Article shall apply to the parking places described in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this order, as "Brandon Street (South)", "College Street" and "Frog Lane".
 - Between 1000 hours and 2000 hours on any day other than a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, any vehicle which has been removed from a parking bay in the parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this order shall not again be left in the same parking place until a period of two hours has elapsed since it was so removed.
- 35. The provisions of this Article shall apply to the parking place described in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this order as "Queen Square".

Between 0800 hours and 1800 hours Monday to Friday and 0800 hours and 1600 hours Saturday other than Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, any vehicle which has been removed from a parking bay in the parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this order shall not again be left in the same parking place until a period of two hours has elapsed since it was so removed.

- 36. Notwithstanding the provision of Article 3 of this order, the driver of a coach (which for the purposes of this Article means a passenger carrying vehicle licensed as P.S.V. and with seats for more that 16 persons inclusive of driver) may cause or permit it to wait within the parking place described as "Maritime Heritage Centre" in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this order for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, providing that -
 - (a) the coach shall not wait for a period of time exceeding 15 minutes in duration;
 - (b) the driver shall remain at the coach; and
 - (c) the coach shall not wait otherwise than within a bay indicated by sign or surface marking as being available for the purpose of a coach picking up and setting down passengers.
- 37. The provisions of this Article shall apply to the parking place described in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this order as "Wapping Wharf". Nothing in this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the parking place for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle to adjacent properties or moored vessel.

PART 3

PARKING PLACES FOR CYCLES AND MOTOR CYCLES

38. The area specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this order is authorised to be used subject to the provisions of Article 4, Article 5, Article 6, Article 7, Article 8, Article 9, Article 10, Article 11, Article 12, Article 21, Article 22, Article 23, Article 24, Article 25, Article 26, Article 27, Article 28 and Article 29 of this order as a parking place for such vehicle or classes of vehicle as referred to in column 4 of the said Schedule, in such positions and on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that parking place in the said Schedule.

Provided that between 0800 hours and 1800 hours on any day other than a Saturday, Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday no vehicle shall be left in a parking place specified in Schedule 2 to this order for a period longer that two hours at any one time, and that upon removal of any such vehicle from a parking place until a period of one hour has elapsed since it was so removed.

PART 4

REVOCATION OF EXISTING ORDER

39. The Bristol (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) (Consolidation) Order 2000 is hereby revoked.
